PERMIT TERMS and CONDITIONS

1. Rosebud County Road Forman shall be notified a minimum of 48 hours prior to the start of construction or maintenance activities and shall be notified at the completion of construction.

2. Rosebud County reserves the right to inspect the construction activities and to require correction of any deficiencies or nonconformance with this permit. Rosebud County may also require the removal of defective materials or workmanship at the permittee's expense.
 3. An approved encroachment permit is for the specific time, duration, place and type of construction or maintenance and does not, in any way, establish an easement or grant permission to encroach on private or publicly owned lands. Conflicts with previously installed underground utilities and other facilities, owned by others, is the sole responsibility of the permittee.
 4. The permittee is responsible for all traffic control signage, barricades, lighting and flaggers as outlined in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
 5. Rosebud County shall be reimbursed for any materials, equipment, manpower or supplies supplied by the County.
 6. Below-grade encroachments shall be sleeved the full width of the road right-of-way to a depth not less than 6 feet below the surface to the top of the sleeve for the full width of the right-of-way, including the driving lanes, shoulders and borrow areas. Below-grade encroachments locations shall be clearly marked with permanent markers, as appropriate for the type of construction, upon completion of construction. At-grade encroachments shall conform to all traffic safety, road design standards, drainage and intersection location requirements. Above-grade encroachments shall be constructed to maintain a minimum of 14 foot clearance for the full width of the road right-of-way, including driving lanes, shoulder and borrow areas. Support structures are not permitted in the road right-of-way.
 7. Site disturbances caused by construction or maintenance shall be restored to pre-construction conditions. Re-seeding of disturbed areas may be required by the Road Foreman.
 8. Open trench construction methods shall not be permitted on paved roadways or on improved graveled roadways.
 9. Transport of cleated track or chained tired equipment across paved surfaces is expressly prohibited. Paved surfaces are to be protected by floats or pads.
 10. Rosebud County reserves the right to restrict transport of construction equipment and materials based on seasonal road conditions.
 11. Additional site specific conditions may be required as determined by the Road Foreman.
 12. Permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Rosebud County from any claims, damages or costs arising out of permitted activities either by damage to the road improvements or associated facilities or by inconvenience of the traveling public. Permittee further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Rosebud County from any claims, damages or costs arising from future road maintenance, repair, and reconstruction activities or by road relocation conducted by Rosebud County.
- Permittee shall provide a general sketch of proposed encroachment including location, orientation, size, dimensions and distances of existing roadway and other features and proposed encroachment. Engineered drawings may also be attached.
- I agree to comply with all terms and conditions of this permit, industry design standards, accepted construction practices and applicable state and federal requirements for the proposed encroachment. This permit is valid for _____ months from date of issuance.

A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A RADIO TOWER FOR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES IN SOUTHERN ROSEBUD COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Rosebud County Emergency Services is hindered by the lack of adequate radio communications facilities in the Ashland area; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud County Commissioners desire to purchase land upon which to construct a radio communications tower; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County Commissioners have authority to purchase land under 7-8-2201, MCA; and

WHEREAS, a suitable parcel of land has been identified, surveyed, and the survey filed for record with the County Clerk & Recorder as Certificate of Survey 0113064, in Envelope 230A; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the parcel being considered for purchase is described as Tract 1, Certificate of Survey 0113064, within the SESW T3S R44E P.M.M., Rosebud County, Montana; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud County Commissioners have negotiated an agreement to purchase a site from Audrey M. Snodgrass, PO Box 78, Ashland MT 59003 for a 0.5 acre site, near the Range Telephone Tower, for the amount of \$1500.00; and

WHEREAS, the property purchase is exempt from appraisal pursuant to Section 7-8-2202, M.C.A.; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County is to be responsible for the survey, all paper work, fees and any other expenses required for the land transfer; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County is to construct and maintain a fence around the site; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tower shall not impede operation of the Range Tower; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Rosebud County purchase Tract 1 of Certificate of Survey 0113064, within the SESW T3S R44E P.M.M., Rosebud County, Montana as filed for record with the County Clerk & Recorder's in Envelope 230A and to proceed to fulfill the terms of the land transfer agreement.
