No public comment.

Commissioner Lee motioned to accept the bid from Linda Simpson of Lame Deer in the amount of \$4,471.00 for Lot 12 in Block 26, of the town site of Lame Deer MT, minimum bid being \$3,470.00. A quit claim deed will be issued to Linda Simpson within 7 days. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to accept and sign the new lease agreement with the US Postal Service for the Angela MT post office building. This lease agreement will pay \$2,100.00 per year, divided equally for 12 months beginning when the current lease expires, April 8, 2016 to April 7, 2021. The agreement includes a renewal option of \$2,350 for April 8, 2021 to April 7, 2026. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to accept and sign the contract with Ingraham Environmental Inc. in the amount of \$6,249.96, with contingency funds of \$1,000 for permits, etc. to perform asbestos abatement in the old clinic building, to include the reception area and all offices to the south. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, discussion on whether or not this would be the time to abate the entire second floor began. It was concluded that this would more than double the cost and currently the carpet on the north side of the building is still in good shape. The subject of abatement will be addressed when new flooring is required. Motion carried, 3 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to appoint Bryan Swan, Colstrip Public Works Director to the Solid Waste Board for the term ending January 1, 2016. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

There being no letters of interest for the Haying the Airport/Stockyards, Commissioner Lee motioned to accept Commissioner Martens offer to do the haying this season. Commissioner Joiner seconds the motion adding that it would be a one year contract, advertising again next year. The original contract dated March 22, 2011 with Tim Fulton was terminated early with a letter dated January 16, 2015, due to the necessity to add the Stockyards and other provisions. The contract will be offered for a 5 year period when there is outside interest. Commissioner Martens abstains, motion carried, 2 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve and sign the Respite/Personal Care Contract with Rosebud Health Care Center (RHCC) for the term July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016, not to exceed \$6,000. This is budgeted out of Senior Citizens. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion and it was noted that either the care giver or the individual needing care be 60 years of age. Motion carried 3 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to award the Base Bid only and not the alternate to Fisher Construction, in the amount of \$121,700. Commissioner Joiner seconds the motion and it was stated that the alternate bid was accurate, however there are less expensive alternative methods of finishing the ceiling, such as spraying it with a fire retardant insulation, that are being explored. Motion carried 3 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to accept and sign Addendum #9 to the Brown's Excavation Contract for equipment rental, stating that the Solid Waste Board recommended raising the rate to \$100 per hour, not to exceed 90 hours per month. The contract ends June 30, 2016. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO SELL COUNTY TAX-DEED LAND (3 Lots)  
IN SUMATRA**

WHEREAS, the County desires to sell land acquired by tax-deed in Sumatra, Montana; and  
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7-8-2301, MCA, et seq., the County has the authority to dispose of acquired tax-deed land; and  
WHEREAS, said property is described as: Parcel #1 Lot 1 Block 2 (\$80), Parcel #2 Lot 7 Block 12 (\$284), Parcel #3 Lot 5 Block 12 (\$284) of the town site of Sumatra, Rosebud County, Montana, all according to the official plat on file with the Clerk and Recorder of Rosebud County, Montana; and  
WHEREAS, said property was acquired by tax-deed on November 22, 2004 Parcel #1, January 17, 1980 Parcel #2, December 1, 1965 Parcel #3 and the repurchase period for said parcel of land has expired; and  
WHEREAS, the market value of said real property as determined by the Department of Revenue is \$80.00 Parcel #1, \$284.00 Parcel #2, \$284.00 Parcel #3 ; and  
WHEREAS, the County desires to sell said parcel of land to the highest bidder for a value of not less than the minimum market value of \$80.00 Parcel #1, \$284.00 Parcel #2, \$284.00 Parcel #3; and  
WHEREAS, the County shall publish said Notice of Sale pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-1-2121, MCA , including to post said Notice of Sale of Tax Deed Land at three locations within the County: the Rosebud County Courthouse in Forsyth, the Colstrip Post Office in Colstrip, and the Post Office in Sumatra; and  
WHEREAS, the County desires to auction said property by accepting sealed bids for a period of two weeks followed by a live auction at the time of the opening of bids until a high bid is reached; and  
WHEREAS, the bidders must be present at the time of opening of bids and live auction in order to consummate the sale by way of cash or cashier’s check; and  
WHEREAS, the County shall issue a quitclaim deed within 7 days from the close of said auction; and  
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County shall sell the above described parcels of land to the highest bid at the close of the live auction; and  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the opening of bids and live auction will take place on May 19, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the County Commissioners Office located at the Rosebud County Courthouse.
