Commissioner Martens motioned to approve and sign Resolution #883, Setting Commissioner Meeting Dates. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION # 883

RESOLUTION SETTING COMMISSIONER MEETING DATES

WHEREAS; the governing body of the county shall establish by resolution a regular meeting date and notify the public of that date, and;

WHEREAS; the governing body of the county, except as may be otherwise required of them, may meet at the county seat of their respective counties at any time for the purpose of attending to county business, and;

WHEREAS; Commissioners may, by resolution and prior two days' posted public notice, designate another meeting time and place, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the office of the Board of Rosebud County Commissioners, located in the Rosebud County Courthouse, is open Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with extended hours as necessary. All official business conducted on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve and sign Resolution #884, Establishing Office Hours. Commissioner Martens stated that there was some discussion regarding adding the afternoon of Christmas Eve as a time the Courthouse is closed. This was discussed with MACo Attorneys and the opinion is that the County Commissioners do not have the authority to create paid holidays. The offices by statute have to be open. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION #884

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ROSEBUD COUNTY, MONTANA ESTABLISHING OFFICE HOURS

WHEREAS, the County of Rosebud, Montana is a political subdivision of the State of Montana; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-4-102, MCA provides that each officer shall keep the officer's office open for the transaction of business during the office hours determined by the governing body by resolution after a public hearing and only if consented to by any affected elected county officer each day except Saturdays and legal holiday.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana is the governing body of Rosebud County, Montana; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana deems it in the best interest of said County that the County offices of Rosebud County be open for the transaction of business between the hours from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the offices of Rosebud County shall keep their offices open continuously for the transaction of business from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

Commissioner Martens motioned to approve and sign Resolution #885, Resolution Setting Per Diem Policy and Standard Mileage Rates. These rates are set by the state and followed by the county. The only changed from the current rate, is the mileage went up to 56.5 cents per mile. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried 3-0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION # 885

RESOLUTION SETTING PER DIEM POLICY & STANDARD MILEAGE RATES

WHEREAS; Rosebud County has not changed their per diem policy since January 3rd, 2012, and;

WHEREAS; the State of Montana has not adjusted the per diem to a higher rate, and;

WHEREAS; per diem for elected officials shall stay at \$98.00 per day and non elected officials will be allowed rates adopted by the State, motel rates shall not exceed \$77.00 per night plus tax, other than those listed as high cost areas, in state rates will follow any adjustments made by the State, and;

WHEREAS; out of state per diem for elected and non elected officials shall stay at \$125.00 per day, with taxes, \$85.00 room charge, plus taxes and \$36.00 for meals;

WHEREAS; it is recommended that everyone stay in a State rate room whenever possible and;

WHEREAS; since the meals are paid at a higher rate, receipts will not be required. Trip reports and motel receipts need to be submitted with the claim, and;

WHEREAS; Rosebud County recognizes a higher rate of reimbursement may be necessary when traveling to meetings and conferences in and out of state in higher cost areas;

THEREFORE; a County Employee, Department Head or Elected Official can request prior approval for actual expenses to attend meetings in high cost cities, these requests will be determined by the Commissioners on a case by case basis;

WHEREAS; The standard mileage rates have increased to \$0.565 cents per mile for business miles driven;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the above rates will go into effect on January 1st, 2013, and will follow any adjustments made by the State henceforth.

Commissioner Martens motioned to approve and sign Resolution #886, Setting Daily Rate of Credit for Incarceration. After contacting the Sheriff, it was determined that the rate should remain the same. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried 3-0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION # 886

A RESOLUTION SETTING DAILY RATE OF CREDIT FOR INCARCERATION

WHEREAS; pursuant to Section 46-18-403 MCA, County Commissioners must by Resolution set forth the daily rate of credit for incarceration;

WHEREAS; this rate must be set annually;

WHEREAS; the amount allowed or credited may not exceed the amount of the fine;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; Rosebud County hereby sets \$100.00 per day as the rate to be used in all Courts in Rosebud County for credit for incarceration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; this resolution rescinds all previous resolutions and credits for incarceration.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve and sign Resolution #887, Suggested Donations for Senior Meals and Transportation. Commissioner Lee stated that the director of the Senior Citizens Program, Patti Crosby determined the changes needed to keep up with the rising cost of food and fuel. WHEREAS; the Montana legislature has authorized the Board of County Commissioners to set by Resolution the suggested donations for Senior Meals and Transportation amounts for services provided by the Rosebud County Senior Centers.

WHEREAS; the Rosebud County Commissioners, having reviewed the suggested donation and finding the proposal to be reasonable, make the following;
