RESOLUTION # 855

RESOLUTION SETTING STANDARD MILEAGE RATES

WHEREAS; Rosebud County has not changed their standard mileage rates since January 3rd, 2011, and;

WHEREAS; the State of Montana has adjusted the standard mileage rates to a higher rate, and;

WHEREAS; the standard mileage rates have increased to 55.5 cents per mile for business miles driven;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the above rates will go into effect on July 1st, 2011, and will follow any adjustments made by the State henceforth.

RESOLUTION # 856

Resolution Setting County Elected Official Salaries

On a motion by Commissioner *Sioux* and second by Commissioner *Martens* in Regular Session on July 5th, 2011 it carried to unanimously approve the following County Elected Official salaries for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012.

WHEREAS; Section 7-4-2504 MCA requires the county governing body to fix salaries of all elected officials;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; The salaries will be increased as recommended by the Rosebud County Salary Compensation Board by 2% per county official. The salaries will thus be as follows:

- The County Clerk of the District Court, Justice of the Peace shall receive \$46,743.88 base salary.
- The County Superintendent of Schools shall receive \$47,143.88 base salary.
- The County Attorney, as a full-time County Attorney, shall receive \$91,888.05 base salary.
- The County Commissioners, Clerk and Recorder, Treasurer and Sheriff will receive \$48,743.88 base salary.
- The County Coroner shall receive \$408.00 and Deputy Coroners shall receive \$306.00 per month.

Commissioner Martens motions to approve and sign the Contract with the Department of Revenue, leasing out office space in the County Courthouse, totaling \$8,460. Commissioner Sioux seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Martens motions to approve and sign the Cemetery Pasture Lease Agreement with Clayton Jones from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 for \$20 per month per horse with a two horse max. Commissioner Sioux seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Martens motions to approve the Disaster Exemption Biding for the Courthouse Boiler Project due to disaster declaration and time frame restraints. Commissioner Sioux seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.
