All results were checked and the number of ballots counted agreed with the Official Register, Poll Books, Absentees received and Provisional Ballots accepted. Certificates of Nomination were issued to the following party candidates, Douglas D. Martens and Elizabeth Ball-Mavity. The official canvas report was signed and sent to the Secretary of State. Those canvassing were Commissioners, Robert E. Lee and Douglas Martens, Treasurer Kathy Fahrenbruck and Clerk and Recorder Joan K. Duffield.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to accept and adopt Resolution #958 Establishing Fees for Reimbursement of Cost Associated with Tax Lien Sales and Tax Deed Proceedings. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0. Resolution as follows:

**RESOLUTION #958  
RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COST ASSOCIATED WITH  
TAX LIEN SALES AND TAX DEED PROCEEDINGS**

**WHEREAS**, Montana Code Annotated (MCA) Title 15 Chapters 17 and 18 authorize counties to assess all costs associated with tax lien sale and tax deed proceedings against the property subject to the tax lien; and

**WHEREAS**, MCA § 15-17-121(2)(a) specifies which costs may be assessed against the tax lien property; and

**WHEREAS**, MCA § 15-18-21(2) specifies which costs may be assessed against the tax deed property; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners desires to establish, as authorized by law, a fee schedule for reimbursement of its costs incurred in the tax lien sale assignment and redemption process, the tax deed proceedings, as well as preparations of tax deeds, quitclaim deeds, deeds of conveyance and realty transfer certificates;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, as follows:

1. There is hereby established the following fee schedule for reimbursement of the county's costs associated with tax lien sales and tax deed proceedings:

3. This resolution is effective upon passage and approval.

**RESOLUTION #959 APPROVING  
THE SOUTHEAST MONTANA DUI TASK FORCE  
PLAN AND MEMBERSHIP FOR SFY 16-17**

**WHEREAS**, Montana Code Annotated 61-2-106 authorizes the governing body of a county to appoint a task force to implement a county drinking and driving prevention program designed to:

- Prevent driving while under the influence (DUI) of alcohol.
- Reduce alcohol-related traffic crashes.
- Educate the public on the dangers of driving after consuming alcoholic beverages or other chemical substances that impair judgment or motor functions.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana on November 1<sup>st</sup> 1994, officially appointed the members of Southeast Montana DUI Task Force which since that time has continued their mission to reduce alcohol and drug related motor vehicle crashes, injuries and deaths in Rosebud County;

**WHEREAS**, funds to be administered by the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force have accumulated and continue accumulating based on driver's reinstatement fees paid by drivers convicted of impaired driving in Rosebud County, and will be available in the current fiscal year July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. We the commissioners of Rosebud County request that all funding due to Rosebud County for DUI enforcement and education collected pursuant to Montana state statute be disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. We understand the money will be paid through the Custer County Treasurer and disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. The Southeast Montana DUI Task Force will then distribute the monies as needed for DUI enforcement and education throughout the Southeast Montana area of Custer, Rosebud, Prairie and Powder River County.

**WHEREAS**, Section 61-2-105, MCA requires that a local DUI Task Force Annual Plan be approved and submitted to the Montana Department of Transportation for funding;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, that the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force Plan for SFY 16-17 be approved, and that the following shall be appointed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force as Volunteer Community Members:

Commissioner Lee motioned to sign and adopt Resolution #960 to Purchase Oil, Services and Winter Maintenance from the State of Montana. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0. Resolution as follows:

**RESOLUTION # 960**

**Resolution to Purchase Oil, Services and Winter Maintenance from the State of Montana**

**WHEREAS;** Rosebud County has agreed to purchase oil and services from the State of Montana, Department of Highways, and;

**WHEREAS;** the amount of oil and services needed may vary each year depending on the type of work needing done,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED;** that the State of Montana agrees to provide oil and Magnesium Chloride as needed; and provide winter maintenance services on all county roads as specified:

- Intersections in Ashland
- The first 0.7 miles up the Birney/Ashland road
- Around the corner at the intersection of Cartersville and S446
- The overpasses on the first 3 miles of the Castle Rock Road, beginning at mile marker 0.0 on Highway 39 to mile marker 3.0

Rosebud County will reimburse the State of Montana, Department of Highways for any oil and services provided to the County for its use.

Rosebud County authorizes the State of Montana, Department of Transportation, to utilize Rosebud County's turnaround access on Cartersville Road #446 when sanding or plowing.

Commissioner Martens moved to give the employees a 25 cent cost of living increase for fiscal year 2017. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to give an additional increase to those employees that are currently below the recommended wages under the new classification done by Richard Larson and Associates Inc. Commissioner Martens seconds motion stating that he suggests those employees that are currently below the suggested minimum get an additional 75 cents to bring their total increase to \$1.00 for the FY. Those employees whose gap in wages is more than \$1.00 below the minimum get a \$1.00 total increase and the gap in suggested wages will be re-visited again next fiscal year. Motion carried, 2 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to give the elected officials a 25 cent salary increase as noted in MCA 7-4-2503, which applies to the Superintendent of Schools, Sheriff, Clerk of Court, Clerk & Recorder and Justice of the Peace and that the County Attorney receive the same 25 cent raise. Commissioner Martens seconds motion stating that this is the recommendation of the Compensation Board which met on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. Those in attendance were Commissioners Martens, Commissioner Joiner, County Attorney C. Kristine White, Clerk of Court Liz Ball-Mavity, Don Holland local taxpayer and Clerk & Recorder Joan K. Duffield. Motion carried, 2 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to sign the Agreement for Library Services with Treasure County. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to table the Predator Control MOU with the Montana Woolgrowers Association and the Montana Stockgrowers Association until a letter of notification is sent and a discussion has been held with the Federal Program Directors.
