The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on May 31st, 2012, with Douglas D. Martens, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, and Geraldine Custer, Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comment.

The Board of County Commissioners met to discuss with the Compensation Board. The meeting minutes are as follows;

Commissioner Martens called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Commissioner Martens stated that the two private individuals were not able to make it to the meeting.

Mrs. Custer stated that this meeting is to set the elected officials salaries for fiscal year 2013. She continued by saying that for each 1% raise it would cost approximately \$36,000.

Commissioner Lee stated that this year's cost of living increase is 3.2%.

Commissioner Martens asked if the property tax structure is set by Rosebud County.

Mrs. Custer said yes.

Commissioner Lee stated that it increases by 1/8 – 1/4.

Mrs. Custer stated that it is basically frozen.

Commissioner Martens stated that he would like to give the full 3.2% cost of living increase, but at some point in the future feels like the County could run into trouble doing that.

Commissioner Lee asked about entitlement funds.

Mrs. Custer stated that there are cost of living increases with it and also oil money.

Commissioner Lee showed the board a print out of the Revenue vs. Actual Budget that the County has received to date. The general fund has received 95% of its estimated funds and the Treasurer's office has not posted taxes received yet due to this being the last day that taxes are due. Commissioner Lee estimates that the income for the general fund will be at 105% by year's end.

Mrs. Custer stated that the health benefit will not be increasing this year.

Commissioner Lee said he is interested in a 3.5% increase and asked if the County could afford to go more than that?

Mrs. Custer stated that the board could approve a set amount and longevity pay as well for elected officials.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity stated that many counties do give longevity pay to their elected officials.

Mrs. Custer stated that having a guaranteed 1% raise each year could be open for consideration, other counties do it.

Commissioner Martens stated that would be a great incentive to keep good employees with the county due to the private companies in the area that can offer more, such as the oil fields in Sidney.

Commissioner Lee stated that looking into longevity pay would be something to do down the road.

Mrs. Custer stated that deputies at the Sheriff's office already receive longevity pay.

Commissioner Lee stated that having longevity pay for not just elected officials but for regular employees would be something to look in to too.

Mrs. Custer stated that this board is here to set elected officials salaries.

Mr. Hayworth stated that this board is to set elected officials salaries and does not have to decide or approve of longevity pay today. He added saying the Commissioners can look at longevity pay more broadly at a later date and extend it past elected officials if they so choose.

Commissioners Martens stated that in theory if elected officials were given a 4% increase and regular employees less would be the only way to close the gap and not allow deputies a raise. He continued by adding that the Sheriff would also get that same increase, and each deputy would get a percentage of the Sheriff's raise.

Mrs. Custer stated that all deputies get a 1% raise each year for longevity. Mrs. Custer added that she would also like to see elected officials get longevity pay to keep a pay differential between elected officials and regular employees.

Commissioner Lee stated that he is not apposed from looking into it.

Mrs. Custer said that a certain amount each year or a certain % each year helps keep valuable people within the county.

Commissioner Martens stated as an example doing \$100 at 5 year, and \$500 at 10 year mark as a set amount.

Mrs. Custer stated that the MACo website has information on it that tells what other counties are doing and would give examples. She went on to add that the Sheriff also received a 1% guaranteed longevity pay increase each year.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity asked for a recommendation on what the budget would allow.

Commissioner Martens stated that the budget is well ahead of what was expected.

Mrs. Custer stated that the budget can afford a 4% pay increase for elected officials.

Commissioner Martens stated that this year the county can afford it, next year if the environmentalists close down the plants and the oil field in the area boom the county may not be able to afford it.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity stated that the county does seem to retain its people even with not that many perks working for the government.

Mrs. Custer Motioned to approve a 4% pay raise for elected officials.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity seconds motion.

Mr. Hayworth amends motion by calling the 4% raise a cost of living adjustment.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity seconds amendment.

Motion carried, 6-0.

Mr. Hayworth stated that he gave up Forsyth and Colstrip City Court's as their Attorney's this year due to being stretched too thin. His wage lost due to this is \$1,250 per month from the City of Colstrip and \$300 per month from the City of Forsyth. He added that this is an off year for the state and they are not getting bumped up. He also stated that his income was a little lower last year and a 4% increase would bring his salary up to 85% of the District Court Judge's pay.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve a 4% cost of living increase for the County Attorney.

Mrs. Custer seconds motion.

Motion carried, 6-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve a 4% cost of living increase for the County Coroner.

Mrs. Ball-Mavity seconds motion.

Motion carried, 6-0.

Commissioner Martens adjourned the Compensation Board meeting at 3:30 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned sine die.
