RESOLUTION # 892

A RESOLUTION DIVIDING ROSEBUD COUNTY INTO THREE COMMISSION DISTRICTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ROSEBUD COUNTY, MONTANA;

WHEREAS; pursuant to 7-4-2101 of the Montana Code Annotated the Board of Rosebud County Commissioners has divided Rosebud County into three commissioner districts, as compact and equal in population and area as possible. This redistricting into commissioner districts was done pursuant to statute and in accordance with the 2010 census.

WHEREAS; it is resolved that the boundaries of the three commissioner districts have been set and approved by District Judge George W. Huss pursuant to the Order Approving Redistricting Plan Pursuant to the Rosebud County's Proposed Plan for County Commissioner Districts, as Amended, dated October 30, 2103, in Rosebud County Cause No. DV 13-08, and in accordance with 7-4-2103 of the Montana Code Annotated, a copy and a filing of the certification of designated districts has been placed on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Rosebud County, Montana.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the three commissioner districts are set out by the metes and bounds description attached hereto and shall become effective immediately and shall be in full force and effect from this day forward.

Commissioner District One 2013

From the point on the West border of where Rosebud County joins Treasurer County following Interstate 94 to the most Easterly point where Rosebud County joins Custer County then North on the County line which is the line between Range 44 and 45 East to the Northerly point of where Rosebud County meets Garfield County then West on the County line between Rosebud and Garfield County to the most Westerly point where the line meets the Musselshell River then South following Musselshell river to Section 28, Township 10 North, Range 31 East, thence east along the northerly section lines of sections 33 and 34 Township 10 North Range 32 East, thence South along County line between Rosebud and Musselshell County for seven sections, thence East for two sections along county line bordering Yellowstone County, thence South for one section along Yellowstone County line, thence East and South along Treasurer County line to the point it meets Interstate 94, which is the point of beginning.

Commissioner District Two 2013

From the point on the West border of where Rosebud County joins Treasurer County following Interstate 94 to the most Easterly point where Rosebud County joins Custer County, thence south along the county line between Rosebud and Custer counties which is the line between Range 44 and 45 East to the Southeasterly quarter corner of Section 24, Township 2 South, Range 44 East thence west along the Double E Creek to where it meets East River Road and the Tongue River then follow the Tongue River North to where it meets Northerly section line of Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, thence west along line between sections 3 thru 6, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, and northerly line Sections 7 thru 12, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, for fifteen sections which is the length of two and a half townships, thence South on the easterly line of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, for one section, thence west along the southerly line between Sections 7 thru 12, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, and the northerly line of Sections 13 thru 18, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, for 6 sections, to the county line between Rosebud and Big Horn Counties, thence West, North East, North, West along the county line between Rosebud and Big Horn and Treasurer County lines to the point of beginning where the County line intersects with Interstate 94 which is the point of beginning.

Commissioner District Three 2013

Beginning at the Southeasterly quarter corner of Section 24, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, thence west along the Double E Creek to where it meets East River Road and the Tongue River then follow the Tongue River North to where it meets Northerly section line of Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, thence west along line between sections 3 thru 6, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, and northerly line between Sections 7 thru 10, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, for fifteen sections, which is the length of two and half townships, thence South for one section along the easterly line of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, thence west for six sections along southerly line between Sections 7 thru 12, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, and northerly line between Sections 13 thru 18, Township 2 South, Range 41 East, to the county line between Rosebud and Big Horn Counties, thence South on the County line to the Southwesterly corner of Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 41 East, thence East on the County line between Rosebud and Big Horn County to the Southeasterly corner of Section 36, Township 7 South, Range 44 East, thence North along the county line between Rosebud and Powder River Counties to the Southeasterly corner of Section 24, Township 2 South, Range 44 East which is the point of beginning shared with Northeasterly quarter corner of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 44 East.
