Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve and sign Resolution #929 Granting Authority to the Sanitarian. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION #929

A RESOLUTION GRANTING STATUTORY AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY SANITARIAN TO CARRY OUT ASSIGNED DUTIES AND POWERS WITHIN THE PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, MCA 50-50-214(1) states that a license issued pursuant to Title 50 is not valid until signed by the local health officer in the County where the establishment is located;

AND WHEREAS MCA 50-50-214(2) states that local health officers validate state licenses issued by the department in accordance with Chapter 50 of said Title;

AND WHEREAS the Rosebud County Sanitarian will represent the Rosebud County Board of Health and the Rosebud County Health Officer in validating annual and temporary Food & Consumer Safety license and all other duties in accordance with Title 76 of the Montana Code Annotated;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE ROSEBUD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Rosebud County Commissioners, the Rosebud County Board of Health, and the Rosebud County Health Officer grant authority to the Rosebud County Sanitarian to act on behalf of Rosebud County in carrying out duties prescribed in Title 50 and Title 76 of the Montana Code Annotated, including MCA 50-2-116; 76-3-622; 76-4-101 through 135; and 76-8-101 through 114; all to carry out the purpose of the public health system, in collaboration with federal, state, and local partners.

SAID RESOLUTION FINALLY PASSED AND ADOPTED BY A DULY CONSTITUTED QUORUM OF THE ROSEBUD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONTANA, THIS 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2014.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve and sign Resolution #930 Adopting Minimum Standards of Sanitation, with the approval of County Attorney, C. Kristine White. Commissioner Martens seconds motion, motion carried, 2 – 0. Resolution as follows;

RESOLUTION #930 Adopting Minimum Standards of Sanitation

MINIMUM STANDARDS are based on proven technology, set forth requirements for the design and preparation of plans and specifications for subsurface wastewater treatment systems.

WHEREAS, Local Boards of Health are charged with the responsibility of guarding against the introduction of communicable disease in 50-2-116, (1), (g), M.C.A.; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to establish rules to protect the health, safety, and the general welfare of the people of Rosebud County pursuant to the authority granted to the local board under 50-2-116, M.C.A. The general objectives of the rules include the following:

- (1). to protect the public health, safety, and welfare by setting forth minimum standards for the construction, alteration, repair, extension, and use of wastewater treatment systems within the county.
- (2). Local board of health has adopted regulations no less stringent under 50-2-130 MCA, for wastewater treatment systems for private and public buildings not regulated by Title 75, chapter 6, or Title 76, chapter 4.
- (3). Existing uses of state waters and the level of water quality necessary to protect those uses must be maintained and protected; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud County Environmental Health orders to extend present laws controlling water supply, sewage disposal, and solid waste disposal to include individual wells affected by adjoining sewage disposal and individual sewage systems to protect the quality and pot ability of water for public water supplies and domestic uses and to protect the quality of water for other beneficial uses, including uses relating to agriculture, industry, recreation, and wildlife; and

WHEREAS, Under MCA **75-5-101**, it is the public policy of this county to: conserve water by protecting, maintaining, and improving the quality and pot ability of water for public water supplies, wildlife, fish and aquatic life, agriculture, industry, recreation, and other beneficial uses; provide a comprehensive program for the prevention, abatement, and control of water pollution; and balance the inalienable rights to pursue life's basic necessities and possess and use property in lawful ways with the policy of preventing, abating, and controlling water pollution in implementing the program referred to subsection 2; and

WHEREAS, these minimum standards shall be adopted on NOVEMBER 6, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that minimum standards are hereby established by the Rosebud County Health Board and the Rosebud County Commissioners. That the authority to enforce minimum standards is hereby delegated to the Rosebud County Health Officer and to the Rosebud County Environmental Health Sanitarian as his or her duly authorized representatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that minimum standards be enforced by the Rosebud County Environmental Health Sanitarian and shall be required prior to construction or alteration of subsurface wastewater disposal system and any division of property both in the incorporated and the unincorporated areas of the Rosebud County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rosebud County Environmental Health Sanitarian, shall prepare rules and regulations governing the operation of this programs as set forth in the following documents. Rosebud County adopts this following rules and publications as minimum standards for all associated activities on lands less than 160 acres.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached Sanitation in Subdivision Exclusion Checklist and Subdivision Review Fee Calculation Checklist are incorporated herein by reference.
