RESOLUTION #898 Prosecutorial Assistance

Whereas, the Rosebud County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in the case of *State v. Noah Thompson, State v. Jacob Thompson (a youth, and State v. Bustle.*

Whereas, it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney be appointed to assist in the prosecution of the aforementioned case, and

It Is Hereby Resolved:

That Garry Bunke is hereby appointed as special deputy county attorney for Rosebud County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned cases.

It is Further Resolved:

That under the terms of this agreement, an agreed upon hourly fee will be charged for attorney time provided by Garry Bunke. Witness fees and expenses, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will be the County's responsibility as with all other prosecutions.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve and sign Resolution #899 Prosecutorial Assistance, State v. Sky Littlecoyote, and investigation related to Daniel Lionell Willson, Attorney General. Commissioner Martens seconds the motion, motion carried, 3 – 0. Resolution is as follows;

RESOLUTION #899 Prosecutorial Assistance

Whereas, the Rosebud County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in the case of *State v. Sky Littlecoyote* and an investigative file related to Daniel Lionell Willson.

Whereas, it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney be appointed to assist in the prosecution of the aforementioned case, and

Whereas, Mont. Code Ann. § 44-4-111 authorizes and contemplates that the training coordinator for county attorneys and the bureau chief of Prosecution Services Bureau (together with the deputies within said bureau) act as special counsel on request of the county attorney and upon the approval of the board of county commissioners, and

Whereas, Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-501(6) authorizes the Attorney General to provide assistance to county attorneys in the discharge of his or her duties.

It Is Hereby Resolved:

That the attorneys assigned to the Prosecution Services Bureau of the Department of Justice are hereby appointed as special deputy county attorneys for Rosebud County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned case and that any of said deputies can fulfill the functions set out in Mont. Code Ann. § 44-4-103.

It is Further Resolved:

That under the terms of this agreement, no fee will be charged for attorney time provided by the Bureau based upon the fact that pursuant to the internal operational policies adopted by the Attorney General September 1, 1999, assistance in such cases is provided without an hourly fee. Witness fees and expenses, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will be the County's responsibility as with all other prosecutions.

Commissioner Martens motioned to approve and sign Agreement for Library Services with Treasure County. Commissioner Joiner seconds the motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

Rosebud County Montana, which claims an exemption from subdivision review under 76-3-207(1), MCA;

**Whereas**, Rosebud County Commission is a party to this covenant and such covenant may be revoked only through mutual consent of Rosebud County and the land owner; and

**Whereas**, Rosebud County Commission has examined such plat and has determined that the claim of exemption meets the requirements of Rosebud County Subdivision Regulations and the Montana Subdivision and Platting Act;

**Now Therefore Be It Resolved**, the Rosebud County Commission approves the agricultural covenant.

**RESOLUTION # 900**

**Resolution to Rescind Resolution # 332 Which Vacated Antelope Creek Subdivision and by this Resolution #900 to Restore the Antelope Creek Subdivision**

**WHEREAS**, Antelope Creek Subdivision, located in the SE<sup>4</sup> SW<sup>4</sup> of Section 18, T6N R41E P.M.M., Rosebud County, Montana was approved by the County Commission February 17, 1984 by Resolution #194 and filed as Document #42773 in Envelope 51B(Lg) in the Office of Rosebud County Clerk & Recorder on February 24, 1984; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 1991 Roger D. McCaffree and Judie L. McCaffree, as sole owners, submitted a petition to the County Commission to vacate the plat of the Antelope Creek Subdivision as allowed by 7-5-2501, MCA; and

**WHEREAS**, upon consideration of the request, the County Commission found that the petition complied with the provisions of 7-5-2501, MCA and that the Board of Commissioners was the proper body to act upon the petition; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission granted approval to the petition to vacate the Antelope Creek Subdivision Document #42773, Envelope 51B(Lg), by passing and adopting Resolution #332, dated March 14, 1991; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with 7-5-2501, MCA, the legal description of the property reverted to the previously filed legal description identified as Tract B of Certificate of Survey #23824, dated June 5, 1979 as filed in Envelope 80B in the Rosebud County Clerk & Recorder's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, Roger D. McCaffree, Clint D. McCaffree and Brooke McCaffree, all having an interest in the ownership of Tract B, Certificate of Survey #23824, Envelope 80B, have submitted a petition, dated October 8, 2013, to the County Commission to rescind Resolution #332, whereupon Antelope Creek Subdivision would be reestablished, as previously filed, as Document #42773, Envelope 51B(Lg), together with all appurtenances and attachments including Covenants For Antelope Creek Subdivision, dated November 9, 1983; Covenants For Antelope Creek Subdivision, Revised September 11, 1985; the Montana Department of Health and Environmental Sciences letter of conditional approval, dated

January 30, 1984; all Montana Department of Transportation Approach Permits and accompanying approach design sheets as are attached to Certificate of Survey #42773, Envelope 51B(Lg); Rosebud County Resolution #194, dated February 17, 1984 granting conditional approval to the Antelope Creek Division; and all other attachments, exhibits, or documents as may be included in Envelope 51B(Lg); and

**WHEREAS**, Roger D. McCaffree, Clint McCaffree and Brooke McCaffree have jointly petitioned the County Commission for this Resolution as each has an interest in the property. On October 11, 2013 the parties signed their petition before Martina Hould, Notary Public for the State of Montana as indicated on Exhibit A attached hereto. All parties are in agreement with the Resolution #900 which rescinds Resolution #332; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission has sought competent legal advice and has received constructive comments from County staff regarding the suitability and the consequences on the land records of the proposed action; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission has examined all documents currently known to be of record regarding Certificate of Survey #23824, as found in Envelope 80B and Antelope Creek Subdivision, Document #42773 as found in Envelope 51B(Lg); and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission has determined that rescinding Resolution #332 is within the authority of the Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Resolution #332 be rescinded and that Antelope Creek Subdivision be reinstated as approved by Resolution #194 and filed as Document #42773 in Envelope 51B(Lg) in the Rosebud County Clerk and Recorder's Office, together with all attachments, exhibits and documents as are included in Envelope 51(Lg).


