The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on September 9, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners Office, with Robert E. Lee, Presiding Officer, Douglas D. Martens, Member, Ed Joiner, Member and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comment.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to adopt Emergency Ordinance 14-1 Prohibiting the Carrying of Weapons, Firearms and Explosives in certain County owned buildings and property. Commissioner Martens seconds motion stating that this covers the courthouse only and is primarily for Courtroom situations, motion carried, 3 – 0. Ordinance is as follows;

Rosebud County Emergency Ordinance
No. 14-1
Prohibiting the Carrying of
Weapons, Firearms and Explosives in certain County
owned buildings and property

Section 1: Statement of Authority and Purpose.

- (A) MCA § 45-8-351 authorizes the County to prevent and suppress the carrying of concealed and unconcealed weapons to public assemblies and publicly owned buildings; and
- (B) MCA § 45-8-328 (1)(a) prohibits the carrying of a concealed weapon with or without a permit in any building owned or leased by the federal, state or local government; and
- (C) MCA § 45-8-333 prohibits the possession of explosives where such possession intimidates, terrifies or endangers another human being; and
- (D) MCA § 7-8-2201 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to manage County property; and
- (E) Courthouse security and workplace security are issues of increasing concern in Montana and the nation;

Section 2: Prohibition of Weapons and Explosives.

The carrying or possession of weapons as that term is defined by MCA § 45-8-316 (1993), any firearm as defined by 18 U.S.C. 921 (a)(2), or explosives in or on the County owned building and property described below by any person except law enforcement personnel is prohibited.

Section 3: Areas Subject to Prohibition.

The County owned property to which the above prohibition applies is:

Rosebud County Courthouse, located at 1200 Main Street, Forsyth, Montana, including all lawns, parking areas and sidewalks leading to the building;

Section 4: Penalties

A person convicted of carrying or possessing weapons, firearms or explosives in or on County property where the carrying or possession of weapons, firearms or explosives is prohibited shall be fined not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or be imprisoned in the County jail for a term not to exceed six (6) months, or both.

Section 5: Signing.

The Building and Grounds Department is directed to procure and place suitable signs at each entrance to the above-listed facilities stating the possession of weapons, firearms and explosives on the premises is prohibited except for law enforcement personnel.

Section 6: Severability.

If a part of this ordinance is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid part remains in effect. If a part of this ordinance is invalid in one or more applications, the part remains in effect in all valid applications.

Section 7: Statement of Emergency.

Recent shooting and weapons incidents in courthouses, schools and worksites in Montana and neighboring states require immediate action to establish a prohibition on weapons in the County Courthouse. The carrying and possession of weapons, firearms or explosives in County buildings and on County property endangers public safety and requires immediate action. The County does not currently have an ordinance establishing a prohibition on weapons in the County Courthouse.

Section 8: Effective Date.

This ordinance is effective as an emergency ordinance immediately upon adoption by a 2/3 majority of the County Commissioner and shall be effective for a period of ninety (90) days unless earlier repealed by action of the Board of County Commissioners.

Commissioner Martens motioned to award the bid for two (2) new law enforcement vehicles for the Sheriff's Office to Heberle Ford of Forsyth. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3 – 0. The bid for two (2) 2014 Ford vehicles, (2) Expedition 4 Dr. 4X4 119" Wheel Base Special Service Vehicles for the purchase price of \$33,645.00 each was the only bid.

Commissioner Martens motioned to approve and adopt the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget as presented, noting that the budget only has 18% cash reserve instead of the 30% that is normally preferred. He also mentioned that the commissioners had capital expenses for the Road Department in the Federal Mineral budget and they are also in the Road Department regular budget, he proposed moving those funds (\$500,000.00) from Federal Mineral to the General Fund to increase the reserve. Commissioner Joiner second motion, motion carried, 3 – 0.

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF ROSEBUD COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS RESTRICTING CARRYING OF WEAPONS
OR FIREARMS WITHIN THE ROSEBUD COUNTY COURTHOUSE
1200 MAIN STREET, FORSYTH MONTANA

WHEREAS, Section 45-8-351(2)(a), Montana Codes Annotated, allows a county government the power to prevent and suppress the carrying of concealed or unconcealed weapons to a public assembly, publicly owned building, park under its jurisdiction, or school, and the possession of firearms by convicted felons, adjudicated mental incompetents, illegal aliens, and minors and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, have determined that it would be appropriate to restrict the carrying of any weapons or firearms of any type into the county owned Rosebud County Courthouse, located at 1200 Main Street Forsyth, Montana, including all lawns, parking areas and sidewalks leading to the building in order to preserve public safety.

WHEREAS, the Commission held the first reading and adoption of this Ordinance on September 16th, 2014 and issued notice of intent to the public, and

As detailed herein, we have agreed upon the sale transfer terms for Acquired Tract A of Lot 3 and the Acquired Tract B of Lot 3 as shown on the Amended Plat, Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6, Block 58, Forsyth Original Townsite which will be recorded upon approval of the parties.

The County shall pay Myrna and Gary Baker the sum of \$2000.00, transfer title to the shed located behind the Senior Citizen Center, and transfer title to Acquired Tract B to Gary and Myrna Baker. In consideration thereof, Gary and Myrna Baker shall transfer title to Acquired Tract A to Rosebud County.

The County has voted to approve the sale and transfers upon the approval by the lender for both Myrna and Gary Baker.
