RESOLUTION #993

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING POLICY FOR ASSIGNING A TAX LIEN WHEN MORE THAN ONE PERSON SEEKS ASSIGNMENT OF A TAX LIEN

WHEREAS, MCA §15-17-323(1)(b) states that the County Treasurer shall develop a policy for assigning a tax lien when more than one person seeks the assignment and provides proof of mail notice to the person to whom the property was assessed. The County Treasurer shall seek input from the County Clerk and Recorder and the County Attorney in developing the policy.


WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has proposed the following policy to determine prioritization of parties seeking assignments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana as follows:


1. There is hereby established the following policy for assigning a tax lien when more than one party is seeking a tax lien assignment: Assignments are given on a first come, first serve basis.
2. When more than one request is received simultaneously, the methods below will be used to establish priority. These methods will be considered in the order that they are listed.
 - Requests for assignment that are received will be processed for priority purposes by date of receipt. Postmark dates will be further used to determine priority items of mail received in the same batch.
 - Requests for assignments that are delivered in person will be deemed received at the time of delivery.
 - As a last resort, the names of the parties will be written on papers, and blindly drawn for by the Clerk and Recorder in the presence of the County Treasurer.
3. This resolution is effective upon passage and approval.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution #996, Resolution for the Adoption of Hirsch Road as a County Road. Commissioner Martens seconds motion. Discussion was held. Commissioner Joiner highlighted the fact that the public hearing for the Hirsch Road Adoption has been advertised in the newspaper on August 3rd and August 10th, 2017. Commissioner Lee stated the reason to meet in public hearing is due to the fact that Rosebud County is aware that the recorded documentation for historically travelled roads is sporadically incomplete. County Planner John Marks was also presented. Planner Marks supports the Resolution, adding that some of the roads were done by petition so the purpose of this Resolution is to list the roads individually and how they can be found. He confirmed Hirsch Road is now formalized and there are no missing pieces. Motion carried 3-0. Resolution signed as follows:

RESOLUTION #996

Resolution for the Adoption of Hirsch Road as a County Road.

WHEREAS, Rosebud County has become aware that the recorded documentation for historically traveled roads dating from the 1880's is sporadically incomplete, may not be clearly described or cannot otherwise be verified by recorded documents; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County has conducted research and inventoried recorded documents pertaining to road easements for historically traveled roads; and

WHEREAS, Under the authority of MCA 7-14-2107 and 2108, Rosebud County has requested and received road easements to fill voids in the public record and has recorded these easements in the Clerk & Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County now has a complete, verifiable and recorded list of documents which validates that all associated road rights-of-way are in the public domain, directly owned by Rosebud County, or the easements have been granted to Rosebud County; and

WHEREAS, a list of the specific recorded documents and the associated recording information for this right-of-way is attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County has authority to adopt such rights-of-way as County roads under MCA 7-14-2101

NOW, THEREFORE, Rosebud County hereby adopts Hirsch Road as a County Road, as this road right-of-way currently exists on the land in the public record upon this day 15th of August, 2017
