Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Martens seconds motion; motion carried, 3-0.

Discussion was held regarding revision and adoption of Policies for the Forsyth Cemetery. The Board of Commissioners previously met with Cemetery Manager, Doug Goyette, and Stevenson & Sons Funeral Director, Frank Arb, both of whom input suggestions for the revision of Policies for the Forsyth Cemetery. Commissioner Lee motioned to adopt the new Policies. Commissioner Martens seconds motion; motioned carried 3-0. The new Policies for the Forsyth Cemetery are as follows:

**POLICIES FOR THE FORSYTH CEMETERY**

1. PRICE

a) Single Lot	County resident	\$ 100.00
b) Single Lot	NON-County resident	\$ 200.00*
c) Full Burial	\$ 350 (Example: Full Burial on weekend is \$350 + \$250 = \$600)	
d) Cremation Burial	\$ 175	
e) Monday Funeral	additional \$100, grave must be dug on the weekend	
f) Saturday & Sunday	additional \$250 full, \$125 cremation, Sextant must work overtime	
g) Holiday	Emergency Only, additional \$300 full, \$150 cremation, Sextant must work overtime	

A non-resident is anyone who has not lived in or owned land in Rosebud County within one year of the time which the lot(s) are purchased, or within one year of interment.

\*A non-resident will pay an additional \$100.00 at the time of interment to aid in the perpetual care of the grave space.

2. The purchase of any lot in the Forsyth or Colstrip Cemetery entitles **only the right of interment.**  
Planting of trees and flowers are prohibited.

3. Lots are sold for no other purpose than for burial of Human Bodies or ashes of same. As Montana law has stricken the word deed from cemetery lot certificates, certificates should state "conveyance" rather than "deed".

4. Should an interment be made on a lot with questionable ownership, the wrongful party must bear the cost for disinterment and re-interment in another lot should a dispute arise.
5. When a lot owner dies intestate, the heirs are recognized according to the laws of Montana.
6. No sale, assignment or transfer of a lot shall be valid without the consent of the County and entry must be made on the records; lots cannot be sold independently and may be sold back to the county for the purchase price paid. A previously purchased lot may be "given" to a family member. No paperwork is required but the change(s) must be noted in the cemetery records.
7. All flowers must be removed from the cemetery within seven (7) days after Memorial Day; or they must be attached to the monuments or placed in floral containers installed in the concrete bases in the monuments.
8. No fencing, roping or enclosure of any nature will be permitted upon graves or lots, except cornerstones.
9. No advertisement of any form will be permitted within the cemetery. Picking of flowers, breaking or injuring trees, plants or any other property within the cemetery is strictly prohibited. Fast driving will not be allowed. Vehicles must be kept on roadways. Neither picnics nor parties will be allowed on the grounds; and all children will be accompanied by an adult. Dogs will not be admitted to the grounds unless they are on a leash.
10. Monuments shall not exceed a total height of 24 inches and must be installed on a concrete slab 4 inches thick with a minimum of 6 inches for a border of the monument base and shall be flush with the ground and within the boundary and properly centered. Benches are allowed, but benches with a back are not allowed.
11. A casket or urn, in addition to a vault must be used for all burials. Containers/vaults shall be constructed of substantial materials other than wood. (Recommended maintenance vaults are fiberglass). Installation of section liners shall not be permitted.
12. No stacking of burials will be permitted with the exception of one cremated human remains on any individual grave space. Each space is solely intended for one burial.
13. No more than two burials per grave space. The two burials could include one full burial and one infant; one full burial and one cremation, or two cremations. Multiple burials per grave space, as stated above, shall be laid to rest as follows: one to the head and one to the foot of the grave. Monuments must be placed according to the rules and regulations.
14. Rosebud County is not responsible for maintenance of headstones.

Discussion was held regarding reviewing and adopting Resolution #980 Requesting a Mail Ballot Election for the 2017 Federal Special Election to Fill the Office of the United States Representative for Montana, Contingent upon Passage of SB305. Commissioner Martens states there is some disagreement as to how the law reads regarding the handling of this matter. Clerk and Recorder Joan K. Duffield is of the understanding that she can send a letter which would have the same effect as passing a Resolution. MACo states the Commissioners are to do a Resolution. In either case, MACo must have this in writing by Thursday, March 16, 2017. Commissioner Martens motions to approve Resolution #980. Commissioner Lee seconds motion; motion carried 3-0. Resolution 980 as follows:

RESOLUTION No. 980

**A Resolution Requesting a Mail Ballot Election for the 2017 Federal Special Election to Fill the Office of the United States Representative for Montana, Contingent upon Passage of SB305**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ROSEBUD COUNTY, MONTANA, as follows:

WHEREAS, Governor Bullock of the State of Montana has called for a Federal Special Election to be held on May 25, 2017 to fill a vacancy in the Office of the United States Representative for Montana; and

WHEREAS, the Montana State Legislature is considering SB 305, An Act Generally Providing How the Special Election to Fill the 2017 Vacancy in the Office of the United States Representative for Montana May be Conducted; and Providing for an Immediate Effective Date; and

WHEREAS, passage of SB 305 would allow the May 25, 2017 Federal Special Election to be conducted by mail ballot; and

WHEREAS, §13-19-202, MCA allows a governing body to request that the election administrator conduct an election by use of mail ballots; and

WHEREAS, it appears that a mail ballot election will be economically and administratively feasible to conduct; and


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows:





funding. At the public hearing, everyone will be given the opportunity to express their opinions regarding Rosebud County's needs and the type of projects that should be considered. Comments may be given orally at the hearing or submitted in writing before 1:30 PM on March 16, 2017.

Dear Rosebud County Commissioners:

The Northern Cheyenne Ministerial Association (NCMA), is requesting your endorsement of **\$150,000** for a newly constructed community facility thrift store that will serve an overwhelming need on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation. The NCMA, is a nonprofit organization that has been active since 1987, and consists of members and partners from 12 churches that work together towards a common mission. Further, the NCMA has expertise in operating an existing Thrift Store since 2012 in the community of Lame Deer, and has the capacity to complete this project and fully utilize resources. The organization is managed by an 8 member Board of Directors and three employees that have shown a very strong commitment to the cause. The newly constructed community facility thrift store will consist of a **72 ft. x 120 ft. main floor** and full basement for storage and sorting purposes.

The NCMA respectfully requests of the Rosebud County Commissioners to endorse this thrift store building project with application through the **CDBG-ED** in the amount of **\$150,000**. Funds will specifically be used towards the building construction. In addition, three jobs will be retained and three new LMI jobs created; with a total of six (6) new jobs created for Thrift Store operations.



As demonstrated in the proposed budget above; the NCMA Thrift Store Boards diligent efforts to look at other sources have been remarkably beneficial in securing funds to start building the new Thrift Store. Currently, the basement is in place and the first floor shell consisting of siding, trusses, roof, shingles, and windows has been completed to seal in the building prior to the

onset of wintry weather. This was achieved through the MT Coal Board Grant funds in the amount of \$300,000. The Rosebud County Commissioners were very instrumental in this endeavor and recently demonstrated their support again through approval for the NCMA Thrift Store Board to apply for CDBG-ED funding. The NCMA deems that the magnitude of this Thrift Store project aligns with the CDBG-ED focus on job retention and new LMI jobs created. Whereby building capacity for economic development on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation. Through your support, the NCMA will create a vital community resource that will impact thousands of lives in countless ways. Allowing us to create stability from crisis, bring hope to the hopeless, and inspire ongoing growth towards self-sufficiency and fulfillment. Ultimately, it will create empowering changes for its employees, volunteers as well as families, communities, and the entire reservation.
