It Is Hereby Resolved:

That Hanna Schantz is hereby appointed as special deputy county attorney for Rosebud County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned case.

It is Further Resolved:

That under the terms of this agreement, the County will pay Hanna Schantz the county rate for special prosecutor fees. Witness fees and expenses, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will be the County's responsibility as with all other prosecutions.

Discussion was held regarding the Northern Cheyenne Ministerial Association CDBG Application for the Northern Cheyenne Ministerial Association's Thrift Store Building Project in Lame Deer. Present at the Board meeting were Willis Busenitz and Dennis Bauer. Mr. Busenitz presented the NCMA's business plan which was put together by June Beartusk, shared photographs, and advised the Board of County Commissioners what is taking place as far as the CDBG submission for the NCMA Thrift Store Building Project. Mr. Busenitz stated that the next step in applying for the 125,000 grant is to get a Resolution from the County Commissioners in support. The CDBG application was originally scheduled to be due on December 1st. Commissioner Lee states there will need to be one or more public hearings. Those public hearing dates, places and times will need to be advertised in the local paper. It was discussed and agreed that there should be one public hearing held in Lame Deer and another one in Forsyth. Due to time constraints and requirements to advertise and hold public meetings and also obtain a letter of support from a Certified Regional Development Corporation, the submission for application will be set back to January 1, 2017. Mr. Busenitz stated that Gerry Fritts will be working with Jim Atchison to try to secure the needed report. It was discussed that Mr. Fritts is also working on obtaining another grant. Gerry Fritts will contact the Commissioners to coordinate both meetings, which will then be advertised in the local paper. Both meetings can be advertised in the same ad.
