WHEREAS, that transfer resulted in a negative balance in the road fund budget;



• **SECTION C - Eminent Domain** Page 9

This statement is essentially correct. However, restricting the establishment of legal access to undefined future subdivisions by eminent domain only, appears to be in conflict with Exhibit B (4) and (6) and Exhibit C. See further discussion below. The County cannot be forced to exercise eminent domain. The language used appears to eliminate all other options for the land owner to establish public access as may be required by title insurance for future divisions.

• **Exhibit A - Legal Description**, Page 14, 15

The property legal description must follow the previous legal descriptions or recorded surveys. See MCA 76-6-207(1). Adding a qualifying phrase (east or west of Cohagen Road) appears to create new divisions of land less than 160 acres in size, which are subject to survey and review by the County.

• **Exhibit B - (6) Transfer of Land**, Page 19

The language of this subsection is vague and appears to be inconsistent with the proposed tracts as described in the legal description detailed in Exhibit A. Subsection 6a is prefaced with the word "if", implying (maybe) that no division of land is created by this document. The apparent intent of the legal description (Exhibit A), however, is to create two distinct tracts.

There is clear intent in ss (6) to potentially create three parcels in the future, but there is no clear connection between the three potential parcels and the defined building envelopes. There are no apparent limitations on the size of the potential future divisions. Including a requirement such that future divisions of land must be 160 acres or greater in size protects the open space concept, yet would not conflict with the building envelope acreage provisions.

The reference in Subsection 6(a) to "... as permitted by Exhibit B, paragraph 7." appears to be in error.

• **Exhibit B - (9) Roads** Page 18

The second paragraph of this subsection provides for easements to governmental entities citing MCA Title 70 Chapter 30. There are several additional methods by which governments may obtain easements. A more appropriate cite for this paragraph is MCA Title 7 Chapter 14 Part 21. Note that a reference to Title 70 Chapter 30 is included within this code section, MCA (7-14-2101(1)(b)(iii).

• **Exhibit C - (8) Roads** Page 24

The limitation of allowing only eminent domain has the potential to prohibit the allowed future divisions mentioned elsewhere in the document. See comments on Exhibit B above. The

County cannot be forced to use eminent domain to satisfy a private need to establish insurable access for title issues.

• **Access & State Lands**

The County and private land owners are now required to secure easements across school trust lands, see MCA 77-1-130. Cohagen Road crosses, in part, Section 32 T10N R35E, near Ingomar; Section 16 & 9 T10N R36E, and Section 16 T11N R36E. These school trust lands are not within the proposed conservation easement, but they are part of the legal access to the whole of the L7 Ranch properties. At this time, Rosebud County has not secured access across these particular School Trust parcels.

If title insurance requires access that is recorded, then Mr. Roberts, as a private land owner, may also apply to the state for easement across the school trust lands. This is a question for your selected title company.
