An incorrect ruling could dramatically reduce tax revenues, and it is the Commissioners' opinion that Western Energy's decision to appeal the ruling is justified and necessary. Motion carried, 2-0.

WHEREAS, Rosebud County gave notice of its intent to amend its subdivision regulations and hold a public hearing on April 24, 2018 pursuant to MCA 76-3-503. Said notice was published in the Independent Press on March 29, 2018 and April 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing on April 24, 2018, no public comment was received; and

WHEREAS, the revised subdivision regulations contain new laws passed by the 2017 Montana Legislature and also contains language from relevant court decisions; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Board of County Commissioners now desire to amend the subdivision regulations that conform to the requirements of the Montana Subdivision and Platting Act.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Board of County Commissioners adopts the attached amended Rosebud County Subdivision Regulations 2018.


