The first bid opened was from Sawtooth Emergency Vehicles for a 2019 Ford Diesel Transit Van with a net bid of \$153,100.00 delivered to Forsyth. Some options are listed as well. There is a bid bond of 10% of the Amount Bid.

The second bid was from Apgar Ambulance for a 2019 Ford Transit 250 Type II Ambulance with a net bid of 139,420.00

Commissioner Joiner motioned to take the bids under advisement until Keith Raymond has had a chance to go through them line by line for comparison purposes and come up with his recommendation and to award the bid on Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Lee seconds motion; motion carried 2-0.

At this time June Beartusk submitted the Environmental Review Checklist which determined that the project will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment, and also determined a Categorical Exclusion, an EA or EIS is not necessary. June states she is in favor of the project as it's very beneficial to the community. There will be no environmental impacts as the building is already in existence. This phase of the project is to complete the interior of the Everything Beautiful Thrift Store and they hope to have their doors open before Christmas of this year.

Commissioner Joiner states he is also very much in favor of the project and he will be glad to see it finished up.

Commissioner Lee call for comments of opponents. No opponents of the project appeared and no opposition was given.

Commissioner Joiner states that the Resolution of this matter is set for next Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

WHEREAS, public comment was favorably received and responded to;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rosebud County Commissioners as follows;


That Rosebud County Commissioners adopt the final Environmental Assessment for the new Community Facility Thrift Store Building Project.

The reasoning is that Sawtooth was able to comply on all specs as outlined in the bid advertisement and Apgar was not able to comply with two of the specs. Namely Apgar was not able to build a "high top" roof, and was not able to meet the specs for a forward facing captain's chair with a built-in work station. It is Keith's belief that the two non-complied with specs make up the majority of the cost difference between the two vehicles and recommends the bid be awarded to Sawtooth. Motion carried; 3-0.

Commissioner Martens motioned to accept Option 1A of Allegiance County Health Insurance as presented by Marty McDevitt. Commission Joiner seconds motion; motion carried 3-0.
