The Commissioners held a regular meeting on the Tax Abatement for the Windfarm. Present at the meeting were Joseph Schiffer, Rancher; Jody Williams, John Williams, Mayor of Colstrip; Michael Cressner, Ryan McGraw, Johnny Kinder, and Nick Hiza, Orion Energy; Courtney Chais-Brown, Gary Ryder, Colstrip City Attorney; Rodney Dresbach, RCFD, Traci Wangen, Independent Press; Jim Atchison, South Eastern Montana Development Corporation.

Doug made a motion to take the Resolution for Tax Abatement off the table. Ed seconded motion. Motion carried.

Doug made a motion to Approve the Resolution for Tax Abatement. Ed seconded. Discussion ensued.

Doug answered a couple questions that had been researched since the public hearing on the issue. He informed the group that trained emergency personal will be on the project and they will work with Rosebud County Emergency Personnel. He also said the disposal of the turbines will be done at a licensed landfill, of which there are none in Montana.

Doug then summarized the two public hearings that were held and said the Commissioners have done much research and taken a lot of public comment on the issue. There is no negative Financial impact and politics should not enter into the decision. Current revenues are declining and this is an opportunity to help county tax revenues.

Ed commented that this would bring in new business to the county, some new jobs and let everyone know we are open for business.

Bob added that he will Abstain from voting because the powerline goes through his property but he will speak in favor of the abatement for his constituents in District 1. It will decrease their taxes significantly.

Doug read the proposed Resolution. Public Comments were given. Mayor John Williams spoke against the abatement. He felt the Windfarm will go even if there is no tax abatement. He is for the Windfarm, against the abatement, because government should tax the maximum to give the people as much service as possible.

Jody Williams commented against the abatement. Asked some questions about if any impact money could be used for the Drug Problem in Rosebud County. Encouraged the Commission to look at the big picture and weight all options.

Joe Schiffer expressed his favor for the Windfarm from a rancher perspective.

Gary Ryder, Colstrip City Attorney, spoke and addressed the Abatement process and expressed his desire to have the issue be voted on and feels that it needs more study.

Doug read the Impact Fee Agreement. He explained that there is also a Road Agreement in progress and a proposed Development Agreement in the progress.

Gary Ryder commented that the impact fees need to be shared with Colstrip and Forsyth and they should be included in the process.

John Williams spoke again on behalf of the City of Colstrip reiterating they are against the Tax Abatement, called it a corporate give away.

No Further Discussion on the Tax Abatement. Doug voted yes, Ed voted yes and Bob abstained, motion to approve the Resolution for the Tax Abatement passed.

Doug read the Impact Fee Agreement. He made a motion to sign the Agreement with a .35%. The maximum allowed by law is .5%.

Discussion ensued about the impact fees and it was decided to table the Impact Fee Agreement until legal counsel can be consulted. Doug made a motion to table the Impact Fee Agreement pending clarification. Ed 2nd the motion, Bob abstained, Motion carried.

Since there was no further business, Doug made a motion to adjourn, Ed seconded, all in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 11:55 a.m.

Resolution #1051 as follows:

Resolution #1051

WHEREAS, Clearwater Energy plans to build a 750-megawatt wind generation facility in Rosebud, Custer, and Garfield Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud County Commissioners have received a request from Clearwater Energy Resources requesting a tax abatement under a new industry category as set forth in MCA 15-24-1402 and are authorized under 15-24-1401 to approve the request; and

WHEREAS, this project will have significant benefits to contractors and workers during the construction period to Rosebud, Custer and Garfield Counties and promote economic development and new industry; and

WHEREAS, this project will bring tax relief to the residents of Rosebud County; and

WHEREAS, this project will employ a limited number of steady workers with high paying jobs once completed; and

WHEREAS, two public hearings were carried out, numerous emails and letters and visits by the public were taken in to consideration; and

WHEREAS, Montana laws will govern bonding, decommissioning and environmental concerns; and


WHEREAS, there are separate road use agreements, development agreements, and impact fee agreements.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Rosebud County Board of County Commissioners approve the Clearwater Energy tax abatement as requested. The abatement will be 50% over the first five years increasing 10% per year until year ten when full taxes will be imposed.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve Mechanical Technology's Maintenance Service Agreement for mechanical services provided for the Rosebud County Human Services building in Colstrip. Commissioner Martens seconds motion. Discussion included that Commissioner Joiner spoke with Travis Baker last week, an employee of Mechanical Technology, in regards to the services that would be required. A Maintenance Services Agreement was provided. The services will begin on October 1, 2019 and shall be for one year and then continue year-to-year until the Agreement is terminated. After the initial term, either party may terminate the agreement upon thirty days written notice prior to the anniversary date of this agreement. Commissioner Joiner states this is a good deal for the county and should alleviate some of the problems we've been having with the building. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Joiner opened the floor for discussion regarding Montana Mold Services LLC's estimate of \$11,650.00 for water damage cleanup in the basement of the courthouse. Commissioner Joiner motions to deny using Montana Mold Services LLC's bid. Commissioner Martens seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating dehumidifiers were ordered. Commissioner Martens stated that the mold needed to be cleaned but the problem needed to be resolved, and that buying a building and moving the contents wouldn't solve the issue. Commissioner Joiner suggested waiting until the water table receded and the mold would be less of a problem. Commissioner Lee stated we should wait for the dehumidifiers and go forward from there. Commissioner Martens stated there will likely be a Montana Coal Board grant available that will replace the need of having to use Montana Mold Services LLC at this time. Commissioner Lee will advise Montana Mold Services LLC that we will not be using their services at this time. Motion carried; 3-0.

WHEREAS, Rosebud County has the legal jurisdiction and authority to construct, finance, and maintain the proposed improvements;


