Seasonal Groundskeeper
Job Description

CLASS TITLE: Seasonal Worker

DEPARTMENT: Fair

ACCOUNTABLE TO: Fairgrounds Manager or Groundskeeper Foreman

PRIMARY OBJECTIVE OF POSITION: Under supervision, performs unskilled tasks in the upkeep and maintenance of the fairgrounds. Work varies depending on needs of the job.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Work may be performed in undesirable conditions including heat, cold, and dampness.
- Duties involve physical work, including, crawling, bending, stooping, walking, and climbing, lifting weights up to 50lbs on occasion.

MAJOR AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY AND PERFORMANCE:

- Willingness to be trained to operate various types of equipment at the fairgrounds.
- Performs tasks of grounds keeping and minor building maintenance.
- Willingness to work a modified schedule and/or overtime when deemed necessary.

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 18 years of age to operate equipment but will consider 15 & older for other duties.
- Some work experience in grounds maintenance desirable.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.

EXAMPLES OF PERFORMANCE CRITERIA AND EXPECTATIONS:

- Assigned maintenance tasks to be completed in a timely manner.
- Demonstrates the ability to work with little or no supervision and makes sensible decisions.
- Performs other tasks as needed.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform any non-essential job function.
