The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Douglas D. Martens, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Ed Joiner, Member, Pam Ash with Independ Press, and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims and to approve February minutes. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to renew the Interlocal Agreement between Rosebud County and Treasure County for Retained Counsel. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Joiner motioned to approve Resolution 1128, a Resolution to Abandon a Portion of Slaughterhouse Creek Road. Commissioner Lee seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Martens stating we received a petition from all the landowners requesting to abandon this portion of the road. There is no public access to the section of the road and it has not been maintained by the County. Motion carried, 3-0. Resolution as follows:

**RESOLUTION 1128**

**A Resolution to Abandon and Vacate a Portion of Slaughterhouse Creek Road Between Section 28, Township 5 North Range 40 East, Rosebud County Montana**

**WHEREAS**, the portion of Slaughterhouse Creek was adopted as a county road by Rosebud County January 5<sup>th</sup>, 1928 as noted in the Commissioner's Journal, Book 2, Page 486;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to MCA 7-14-2601, grants authority to the County to abandon county roads and describes procedures and requirements for such action;

**WHEREAS**, Red Canyon Ranch Inc., Vassau Flying X Ranch, Raymond Smith and Anne Smith have submitted a petition to vacate and abandon the road in question in compliance with MCA 7-14-2602;

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Martens viewed the site of the proposed abandonment in the company of the County Road Supervisor, Pat Zent on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in compliance with MCA 7-14-2603;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that public safety and public access will not be reduced by such action and receiving no protest;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to MCA 7-14-2604, a copy of this resolution shall be sent by certified mail to the petitioners.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud County Board of County Commissioners abandon and vacate that portion of Slaughterhouse Creek Road lying between Section 28, Township 5 North Range 40 East and returns the use of such right-of way to the landowner.

Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating that the Department Heads worked together in meetings to come up with the best plan for the County. Motion carried, 2-0. Resolution 1129 as follows:

## Resolution 1129

### Resolution Adopting the Rosebud County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan

**WHEREAS**, the County of Rosebud, Montana, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our county; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Rosebud, Montana, fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan; and


**WHEREAS**, the Montana Office of Disaster and Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency Region VIII officials have reviewed the Rosebud County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan, and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body; and


