The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, Pam Ash, Independent Press and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

This is now the time set for the public hearing which was advertised according to 7-1-2121 MCA to take public comment regarding the redistricting plan for a slight change in Commissioner Districts since the 2020 census revealed a decrease in population. Since no public was present to oppose the re-apportionment, Rosebud County will petition the court to approve the redistricting plan.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Now is the time to open the bids for the Ashland Feeding Program for Seniors. One bid was received from the Heritage Living Center for \$5.00 per meal.

Commissioner Lee motioned to take the bid under advisement. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included that the bid will be awarded at the next regular business meeting. Motion carried, 3-0.

Now is the time to discuss the floodplain application and MDT's request for variance for a proposed bridge project over Hanging Woman Creek out of Birney, MT. This request comes from Sam Johnson at the MT DNRC who indicates no reason to deny the proposed variance request. This variance is similar to requests done in the past with projects like the bridge over Big Porcupine Creek, the residents were provided more than 15-days to provide comment on the floodplain application and the variance request, no public comment was received either for or against the project.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the floodplain permit and variance request from MDT. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

A proposal was received to replace the sidewalk at the Human Service Building in Colstrip, MT. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating that a tree root has caused the cement to buckle and it needs to be repaired to prevent injury for the public or employees who use that building. Commissioner Joiner went over the proposal from Opti Construction, Inc. the work will include the north side sidewalk and the south entrance for a total of \$5,560.00.

Commissioner Lee motioned to award the project to Opti Construction, Inc. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1164, a Resolution Requesting Prosecutorial Assistance for State vs Amende. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1164 as follows:

Whereas, the Rosebud County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance due to a conflict of interest in the matter of **State v. Amende**.


Whereas, it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney be appointed to assist in the prosecution of the aforementioned case, and



## **RESOLUTION 1166**

### **APPROVING THE SOUTHEAST MONTANA DUI TASK FORCE PLAN AND MEMBERSHIP FOR SFY 23-24**

**WHEREAS**, Montana Code Annotated 61-2-106 authorizes the governing body of a county to appoint a task force to implement a county drinking and driving prevention program designed to:

- Prevent driving while under the influence (DUI) of alcohol.
- Reduce alcohol-related traffic crashes.
- Educate the public on the dangers of driving after consuming alcoholic beverages or other chemical substances that impair judgment or motor functions.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana on November 1<sup>st</sup> 1994, officially appointed the members of Southeast Montana DUI Task Force which since that time has continued their mission to reduce alcohol and drug related motor vehicle crashes, injuries and deaths in Rosebud County;

**WHEREAS**, funds to be administered by the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force have accumulated and continue accumulating based on driver's reinstatement fees paid by drivers convicted of impaired driving in Rosebud County, and will be available in the current fiscal year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. We the commissioners of Rosebud County request that all funding due to Rosebud County for DUI enforcement and education collected pursuant to Montana state statute be disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. We understand the money will be paid through the Custer County Treasurer and disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. The Southeast Montana DUI Task Force will then distribute the monies as needed for DUI enforcement and education throughout the Southeast Montana area of Custer, Rosebud, Prairie and Powder River County.

**WHEREAS**, Section 61-2-105, MCA requires that a local DUI Task Force Annual Plan be approved and submitted to the Montana Department of Transportation for funding;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, that the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force Plan for SFY 23-24 be approved, and that the following shall be appointed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force as Volunteer Community Members:


