

OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER, ROSEBUD COUNTY, MONTANA, Held

The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the Rosebud County Employee Deductible Waiver with RHCC Agreement. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating this allows Rosebud County employees who elect to have County health insurance to use Rosebud Healthcare Center services and get \$500.00 of their deductible waived. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the Respite/Personal Care Contract between Rosebud County and RHCC. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating the agreement is for seniors who need respite or in home care while a family member is away or needs reprieve from caring for their loved one. The contract does not exceed \$6,000.00 in the one-year period, unless amended. Motion carried, 3-0.

Now is the time to discuss Rosebud County providing mutual aid compensation for volunteer fire agencies within the county. Rosebud County would like to compensate the volunteer agencies for their assistance during emergencies that go outside of their districts to assist county personnel. Commissioner Lee mentioned that the volunteer departments in Ashland, Colstrip and Forsyth are not funded through tax payer dollars. The windfarm impact fee fund was designated to be used for emergency services so the money would be taken from that fund if approved.

Commissioner Hein motioned to provide a one-time payment of \$5000.00 to the Ashland, Colstrip and Forsyth Volunteer Fire Departments. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned sine die.

The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, C. Kristine White, Rosebud County Attorney, Pam Ash, Independent Press and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims and to approve the May minutes. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Discussion ensued regarding the eight percent (8%) salary increase as recommended from the Compensation Board. At the meeting, held on May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023, it was decided that an eight percent (8%) pay increase would be granted to the Elected Officials. Montana Association of Counties (MACo) sent correspondence using the Consumer Price Index (CPI), which has been used for numerous years as determined by the US Department of Labor. The County Attorney accepted the same raise as all other Elected Officials at the meeting as well. Further discussion ensued regarding employee raises.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the salary increase for Elected Officials based on recommendations by the Compensation Board. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1168 as follows:

## RESOLUTION # 1168

### Resolution Setting County Elected Official Salaries

On a motion by Commissioner Lee and seconded by Commissioner Hein in Regular Session on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, it carried to unanimously approve the following County Elected Official salaries for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024.

**WHEREAS;** Section 7-4-2504 MCA requires the county governing body to fix salaries of all elected officials;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;** the salaries will be increased as recommended by the Rosebud County Salary Compensation Board. The salaries will thus be as follows:

The County Clerk of the District Court, Justice of the Peace, Clerk and Recorder, and Treasurer shall receive \$71,194.29 base salary + \$2,000.00 to equal \$73,194.29.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall receive the elected officials' base salary, or \$71,194.29 + \$400.00 annually for a total of \$71,594.29.

The County Attorney, as a full-time County Attorney, shall receive \$135,350.77 base salary.

The County Commissioners and Sheriff will receive, \$73,194.29 base salary.

The County Coroner and Deputy Coroners shall receive compensation for their time.

Commissioner Lee motioned to increase the salary for the County Attorney by the same eight percent (8%) as the other Elected Officials. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Hein motioned to give County Employees a raise of either eight percent (8%) or two dollars (\$2.00) whichever is greater. Commissioner Lee seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating that the increase in expenses is the same across the board and giving this raise would allow everyone to get about the same pay increase. Commissioner Joiner mentioned that the raise would benefit all employees. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to rescind Resolution 1167, a Resolution Transferring Ownership of the Colstrip Cemetery to the City of Colstrip. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating we had community meetings in Colstrip several times regarding the Colstrip Cemetery. Due to the meetings not being advertised in the paper, they do not qualify as public meetings. Commissioner Joiner included that the public meeting is now being advertised and a new resolution will be executed once proper procedure has taken place. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1169, a Resolution of Intent to Transfer Ownership of Colstrip Cemetery to the City of Colstrip. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1169 as follows:

**Resolution of Intent in Transferring Ownership of Colstrip Cemetery to the City of Colstrip**

**Whereas;** the Colstrip Cemetery is located within the incorporated city of Colstrip, Montana;

**Whereas;** the City of Colstrip has expressed interest in obtaining the cemetery, providing administrative and operation services;

**Whereas;** pursuant to 7-8-101 MCA a public hearing will be held at the Rosebud County Commissioners' Office on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023 pursuant to 7-1-2121 MCA to discuss the impending transfer;

**Now therefore, be it resolved;** the County intends to transfer the property after the public hearing;

Now is the time to discuss the Transfer Station in Ashland, MT. This site is on the property of Shane Wheeler, the contract is good through May 1, 2024. Shane has requested to open negotiations regarding the annual lease payment. Currently the lease is paid at \$150.00 per year, he has requested \$500.00 per month. There is no work required by the landowner to maintain the transfer site. It is all maintained by the County.

Commissioner Hein moved to offer \$500.00 per year for the Ashland transfer site. Commissioner Lee seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating we will send a certified letter to Shane with the offer and request a response within two weeks so that action can be taken further if necessary. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to enter Executive Session to discuss personnel litigation. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner requesting all public to leave the office. Motion carried, 3-0.

The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in an emergency session, this session was called to address the need of an Emergency Declaration for severe flooding and damage to several culverts within Rosebud County. A call was held with Jeff Gates the District Field Officer with Montana Disaster and Emergency Services.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1171, a Resolution Declaring an Emergency for Rosebud County. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1171 as follows:

Emergency Declaration**

**RESOLUTION 1171**

**WHEREAS**, according to the National Weather Service is expecting record or near record amount of rain fall in Rosebud County over the next several days which could cause flooding, flash flooding, severe damage to several roads and culverts within the County, this event started May 31<sup>st</sup> and is expected to continue in to the near future.


**WHEREAS**, restoration of County roads is essential to ensure the health, safety and welfare of residents of the County; and


**WHEREAS**, the County has committed all available resources, taken all possible action to combat and to alleviate the situation and local resources are not adequate to cope with the situation.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Rosebud County Commissioners that an emergency is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-402, MCA

Now is the time, set aside, to hear public comment regarding Rosebud County's intent to transfer the Colstrip Cemetery to the City of Colstrip. No public was present to offer comment, for or against, on the transfer. The public hearing is now closed for comment.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 2-0.

Discuss Letter of Support for Wildcat South sale to State Land Board

Commissioner Hein motioned to write a letter of support to the State Land Board for the purchase of Wildcat South. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Hein stated this is for the land sale east of town. The letter of support was requested by Brian Burky from Fish Wildlife and Parks in Miles City MT. They are interested in purchasing about 1,109 acres of property which will increase public access to the Yellowstone River for hunting and fishing. The intent is to lease land for livestock grazing and will continue to irrigate farm ground. Motion carried, 2-0.

Commissioner Hein motioned to renew the agreement for Treasure County to use the Forsyth Library. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating this agreement allows residents of Treasure County to use the libraries the same as Rosebud County residents since there is no library in Treasure County. It also allows Rosebud County to get the state aide allotted for Treasure County to be used for the libraries in Rosebud County. Motion carried, 2-0.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve Resolution 1170, a resolution Transferring Ownership of the Colstrip Cemetery to the City of Colstrip. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Pat Zent, representing the City of Colstrip, reiterating the transfer is in the best interest of the Colstrip residents. All parties agreed that the maintenance of the cemetery being handled by the City will benefit everyone. Motion carried, 2-0. Resolution 1170 as follows:


**Whereas;** Rosebud County has no objection to transferring the cemetery to the City of Colstrip;

**RESOLUTION# 1172**

**Resolution to Purchase Oil, Services and Winter Maintenance from the State of Montana**

**WHEREAS;** Rosebud County has agreed to purchase oil and services from the State of Montana, Department of Highways, and;

**WHEREAS;** the amount of oil and services needed may vary each year depending on the type of work needing done,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED;** that the State of Montana agrees to provide oil and Magnesium Chloride as needed; and provide winter maintenance services on all county roads as specified:

- Intersections in Ashland
- The first 0.7 miles up the Birney/Ashland Road
- Around the corner at the intersection of Cartersville and S446
- The overpasses on the first 3 miles of the Castle Rock Road, beginning at mile marker 0.0 on Highway 39 to mile marker 3.0


Rosebud County will reimburse the State of Montana, Department of Highways for any oil and services provided to the County for its use.

Rosebud County authorizes the State of Montana, Department of Transportation, to utilize Rosebud County's turnaround access on Cartersville Road #446 when sanding or plowing.
