The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on October 3rd, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Kathy Fahrenbruck, Treasurer, Kristine White, County Attorney, Liz Ball, Clerk of Court Pam Ash, Independent Press and Joan Duffield, Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

A discussion ensued regarding the 95 mills levy issue. It was decided that a decision would be made regarding a Resolution to correct the number of mills levied by October 24th, 2023. This is an issue between the State of Montana and the Counties. The State of Montana has filed a lawsuit against one county for just considering decreasing the mills to be levied.

The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on October 10th, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims and to approve the September minutes. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1176 a Setting Per Diem Policy & Standard Mileage Rates. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating that the state has recently changed the reimbursement rates and the County wanted to stay in alignment with that. Motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1176 as follows:

RESOLUTION # 1176

RESOLUTION SETTING PER DIEM POLICY & STANDARD MILEAGE RATES

WHEREAS Rosebud County has not changed their per diem policy since January 1, 2019, and;

WHEREAS Rosebud County seeks to deviate from the per diem meal rates established by the State of Montana, Section 2-18-501, M.C.A.; and

WHEREAS Rosebud County has authority to establish County policy for reimbursement of meal and lodging expenses and per diem rates for County officers and employees who travel for County business. (40 Op. Atty Gen Mont. No. 77);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2, 2020, THE PER DIEM POLICY FOR ROSEBUD COUNTY IS AS FOLLOWS:

The motel room policy of Rosebud County is to utilize 'State rate' motel rooms whenever possible. Motel reimbursement rates generally will not exceed the state rate of \$98.00 per night plus tax, except as the State of Montana has adjusted the rate for high-cost areas.

Rosebud County recognizes a higher rate of reimbursement may be necessary when traveling to meetings and conferences in and out of state in higher cost areas. A County official or employee may request prior approval for actual expenses to attend a meeting in a high-cost city. The request will be reviewed and approved or denied by the Commissioners on a case-by-case basis.

Trip reports and motel receipts must be submitted with each reimbursement claim.

The meal per diem policy for Rosebud County officials and employees is as follows:

Without a receipt the County will reimburse at the state meal rates, Section 2-18-501, M.C.A., namely Breakfast \$8.25, Lunch \$9.25, and Dinner \$16.00 for a total of \$33.50 per day.

With a receipt the County will pay the face value of the receipt for the meal of the County official or employee up to a maximum of the standard federal rate of Breakfast \$13, Lunch \$15, and Dinner \$26 for a maximum of \$54 per day. The County does not reimburse for tips or gratuities, nor does the County reimburse for alcoholic beverages.

The standard federal per diem rate also includes \$5 for daily incidental expenses, however the County does not pay a flat rate for incidental expenses. To be reimbursed, specific incidental expenses (such as parking) must be supported by a receipt noted as part of the travel claim.

AND WHEREAS Rosebud County will use the standard mileage rate established as per the Internal Revenue Service for County business travel by a county official or employee utilizing a private vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the rates set forth above will go into effect on October 1, 2023, and thereafter will follow any adjustments made by the State to the rates set forth in Section 2-18-501, M.C.A.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 2-0.

Now is the time to conduct the bid opening for a new body scanner for Rosebud County Detention. Tek84 Advanced Security Screening offered a full body scanner with installation for \$139,000.0. The bid meets all specifications required; the quote states training is available for the product.

Commissioner Lee motioned to award the one bid received to Tek84 in the amount of \$139,000.00 as recommended by Allen Fulton, Rosebud County Sheriff. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion, motion carried, 2-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1177, A Resolution Fixing the Mill Levy for State Equalization for Fiscal Year 2024. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating reducing the mill levy is the right thing to do for the tax payers and it is believed by the Commission that it will not have a negative effect on the schools. Motion carried, 2-0. Resolution 1177 as follows:

RESOLUTION 1177

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE MILL LEVY FOR THE STATE EQUALIZATION, COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL EQUALIZATION AND COUNTY ELEMENTARY EQUALIZATION MILL LEVY AUTHORITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, the Department of Revenue has indicated the number of mills that the board of county commissioners may levy upon all property in the state and has determined that the ad valorem tax for Fiscal Year 2024 for the State Equalization Aid is 40.00 mills, the County Elementary Equalization Levy is 33.00 mills, and the High School Equalization Levy is 22.00 mills; and,

WHEREAS, Section 15-10-420(8), MCA states The department shall calculate, on a statewide basis, the number of mills to be imposed for purposes of 15-10-109, 20-9-331, 20-9-333, 20-9-360, and 20-25-439. However, the number of mills calculated by the department may not exceed the mill levy limits established in those sections. The mill calculation must be established in tenths of mills. If the mill levy calculation does not result in an even tenth of a mill, then the calculation must be rounded up to the nearest tenth of a mill; and,


WHEREAS, The Montana Department of Revenue performed the calculation under 15-10-420, MCA, and reported that the levy authority for FY2024 is 77.89 mills; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners has determined that the correct number of mills to be levied for Fiscal Year 2024 for the State Equalization Aid is 32.90 mills, the County Elementary Equalization Levy is 27.00 mills, and the High School Equalization Levy is 18.00 mills, for a total of 77.9 mills;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rosebud County Board of County Commissioners that the State Equalization Aid Levy of 32.90 mills, the County Elementary Equalization Levy of 27.00 mills, and the High School Equalization Levy of 18.00 mills, for a total of 77.9 mills, as determined by the Montana Department of Revenue, for Fiscal Year 2024 are hereby fixed.



It Is Hereby Resolved:


That Hanna Schantz is hereby appointed as special deputy county attorney for Rosebud County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned case.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1179, a Resolution Authorizing MACo to Represent Rosebud County regarding Statewide Mills Issue. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating that the Supreme Court will be asked to determine a ruling on the mill levy issue, since all 56 Montana Counties are being sued, rather than each individual county finding representation, it is worthwhile to have Montana Association of Counties represent us in this matter. Motion carried, 2-0. Resolution 1179 as follows:

RESOLUTION 1179

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MACO TO REPRESENT THE INTERESTS OF THE
COUNTY IN SEEKING A DECLARATORY JUDGMENT FROM THE MONTANA SUPREME
COURT REGARDING STATEWIDE MILLS**

WHEREAS, there is an ongoing dispute regarding the calculation and levying of statewide mills authorized by Mont. Code Ann. §§ 20-9-331, 333 and 360 which now requires a judicial resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Quality Education Coalition has filed OP-23-0592, a Writ of Mandate, with the Montana Supreme Court listing all 56 counties as Respondent; and

WHEREAS, the State of Montana has filed an action for declaratory relief against Missoula County and its Commissioners and Treasurer, in the Fourth Judicial District Court; and

WHEREAS, taxpayers and other parties have made public statements indicating an intent to initiate additional lawsuits against various counties; and

WHEREAS, the ongoing dispute regarding the proper calculation and levying of statewide education mills is an issue of statewide importance, impacting every property taxpayer in the State, which can and should be more efficiently resolved by an original action before the Montana Supreme Court than separate lawsuits in different courts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 7-5-2104 the board of county commissioners has jurisdiction and power, under such limitations and restrictions as are prescribed by law, to direct and control the prosecution and defense of all suits to which the county is a party; and

WHEREAS, Rosebud County is a member of the Montana Association of Counties (MACo);
and


WHEREAS, MACo has proposed to pursue an original action at the Montana Supreme Court on behalf of its member counties seeking a declaration as the proper interpretation of Mont. Code Ann. § 15-10-420 and the Counties' legal rights and obligations regarding levying of the statewide mills authorized by Mont. Code Ann. §§ 20-9-331, 333 and 360;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Rosebud Board of County Commissioners authorize MACo to take all steps necessary to file and prosecute an original action before the

Montana Supreme Court regarding the state wide mill levy calculation issues and to represent interests of Rosebud County in that action.


