The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, Pam Ash with the Independent Press and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims, approve the April minutes and the support letter for the Highway 212 SS4A Funding request. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to appoint Commissioner Hein to the 911 Board as the Rosebud County Commissioner representative. Commissioner Joiner seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating the board would consist of a representative of the following offices: Rosebud County Sheriff's Office, Rosebud County D.E.S. Coordinator, Rosebud County Commissioners, Treasure County Sheriff's Office, Treasure County D.E.S. Coordinator, Treasure County Commissioners, Colstrip Police Department. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the quote received from Speelman Construction for the Colstrip Library roof repair. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating the quote was for \$44,400 with a one-year guarantee. Half will be paid upfront with the balance being paid upon completion. The contractor will work with the State Building Inspector for a permit, proof of insurance has also been submitted. Motion carried, 3-0.

Discussion ensued regarding purchasing supplies locally for building projects. The Commissioners believe it can be recommended that contractors purchase locally but cannot require local purchasing. No action taken.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve Resolution 1192 a Resolution Appointing Special Deputy County Attorney. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1192 as follows:

## **RESOLUTION 1192**

### **A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A SPECIAL DEPUTY COUNTY ATTORNEY UNDER MONT. CODE ANN. § 2-15-501(6).**

Whereas the Rosebud County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in the investigation and possible prosecution of suspect elder exploitation, Montana Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation, Case Number 24-04-02;

Whereas Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-501(6) authorizes the Attorney General to provide assistance to county attorneys in the discharge of his or her duties;

Whereas the Attorney General has created an Elder Justice Prosecutor whose duties include working with local, state, and federal law enforcement and prosecutors to review cases, investigate, and, as appropriate, prosecute crimes involving adult maltreatment including abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation of adults over the age of 60, and other disabled or otherwise vulnerable adults;

Whereas the Elder Justice Prosecutor, Michael L. Fanning, is a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General under Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-502, licensed to practice law in the State of Montana, and who is in good standing with the State Bar of Montana; and


Whereas it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney be appointed to assist in the investigation and possible prosecution of the subject case,


**THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED:** That Assistant Attorney General Michael L. Fanning is appointed as a special deputy county attorney for Rosebud County for the purpose of assisting in the investigation prosecution of the subject case.


**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED:** That Elder Justice Prosecutor will charge no legal fees for attorney time provided under this appointment. Investigation expenses, witness fees and expenses, expert witness fees, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will remain the County's responsibility as would normally be the case if prosecution were being handled solely by the Rosebud County Attorney. Should the case be charged and/or tried, the Elder Justice Prosecutor and the County will arrange separately to pay the Elder Justice Prosecutor's reasonable travel, meals, lodging, and other incidental expenses.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve Resolution 1193, a Resolution Approving the Southeast MT DUI Task Force Membership for fiscal year 2025. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0. Resolution 1193 as follows:

**RESOLUTION 1193  
A RESOLUTION APPROVING  
THE SOUTHEAST MONTANA DUI TASK FORCE  
PLAN AND MEMBERSHIP FOR SFY 24-25**

**WHEREAS**, Montana Code Annotated 61-2-106 authorizes the governing body of a county to appoint a task force to implement a county drinking and driving prevention program designed to:

- Prevent driving while under the influence (DUI) of alcohol.
- Reduce alcohol-related traffic crashes.
- Educate the public on the dangers of driving after consuming alcoholic beverages or other chemical substances that impair judgment or motor functions.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana on November 1<sup>st</sup> 1994, officially appointed the members of Southeast Montana DUI Task Force which since that time has continued their mission to reduce alcohol and drug related motor vehicle crashes, injuries and deaths in Rosebud County;

**WHEREAS**, funds to be administered by the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force have accumulated and continue accumulating based on driver's reinstatement fees paid by drivers convicted of impaired driving in Rosebud County, and will be available in the current fiscal year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. We the commissioners of Rosebud County request that all funding due to Rosebud County for DUI enforcement and education collected pursuant to Montana state statute be disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. We understand the money will be paid through the Custer County Treasurer and disbursed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force. The Southeast Montana DUI Task Force will then distribute the monies as needed for DUI enforcement and education throughout the Southeast Montana area of Custer, Rosebud, Prairie and Powder River County.

**WHEREAS**, Section 61-2-105, MCA requires that a local DUI Task Force Annual Plan be approved and submitted to the Montana Department of Transportation for funding;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, that the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force Plan for SFY 24-25 be approved, and that the following shall be appointed to the Southeast Montana DUI Task Force as Volunteer Community Members:

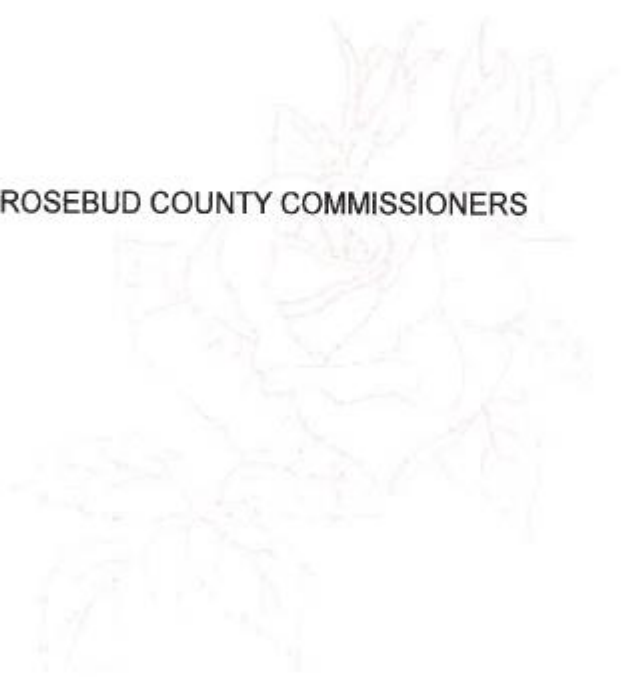
