Addressing old business regarding the Memorandum of Understanding between City of Forsyth and Rosebud County for Prosecution Services. Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the MOU between the City and the County Attorney. Commissioner Lee seconds the motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating the city will pay \$1,365.28 per month to cover cost of City Attorney

services. The County Attorney will receive \$670.00 per month, the misdemeanor civil secretary will receive a \$300.00 stipend for paperwork that is done for the city.
