It is Further Resolved:



The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on December 10th, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, Pam Ash, Independent Press, Sam Beyl, Extension, Charlie Blevins, Fair Board Member and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to purchase a permanent 4-H shed to be used for storage at the Fairgrounds. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating the shed will be purchased from a local vendor, to be placed at the fairgrounds, exclusively to be used by 4-H. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to improve ventilation and repair the bathroom stalls in the North 4-H Restrooms. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Hein stating the repairs would be minor to satisfy the needs of the groups that use the facilities. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to renovate the exterior Exhibit Hall Restrooms. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating, it would be a better use of county funds to wait on this project, with ADA bathrooms being available inside the exhibit hall. Motion denied, 0-3.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the concrete pad to be poured for the sheep and goat area at the fairgrounds. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Sam Beyl with Extension stated concerns have been brought up with drainage. It was agreed that the current set up is working for now. Motion denied, 0-3.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the All-Aboard Train Contract. Commissioner Lee seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating the added attraction will be for the children who attend the fair to ride around during the 2025 fair. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the Artists and Attractions, LLC Contract for the 2026 fair for a magic performer. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Hein stating the concern of signing contracts for a budget that has not yet been approved. The Commission will discuss with the Fair Manager and the Fair Board about implementing a free stage budget to better plan future fairs. Motion carried, 3-0.

The Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana, met in Regular session on December 17th, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in the Rosebud County Courthouse Commissioners' Office, with Ed Joiner, Presiding Officer, Robert E. Lee, Member, Scott Hein, Member, and Clerk & Recorder, present.

No public comments were received as no public was present for the meeting.

Addressing old business regarding the Memorandum of Understanding between City of Forsyth and Rosebud County for Prosecution Services. Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the MOU between the City and the County Attorney. Commissioner Lee seconds the motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating the city will pay \$1,365.28 per month to cover cost of City Attorney

services. The County Attorney will receive \$670.00 per month, the misdemeanor civil secretary will receive a \$300.00 stipend for paperwork that is done for the city. Commissioner Hein states he has concerns but understands it has been discussed with the Commissioner of Political Practices, and the County Attorney's salary will not go over the District Court Judge salary. Commissioner Lee clarified that the remaining balance of the monthly payment will go into the general fund. Motion carried, Commissioners Lee and Hein voting yes Commissioner Joiner voting no, 2-1.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims and to approve the November minutes. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to appoint Sally Wanner as the replacement Clerk & Recorder effective January 1st, 2025. Commissioner Lee said the appointment will fulfill the remaining term of Joan Duffield. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to accept Colstrip EMS Director, Shawn Hage's letter of resignation as of December 31, 2024. Commissioner Hein seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to appoint Kyla Schleuning as the replacement Colstrip EMS Director effective January 1st, 2025, with a wage of \$1000.00 per month in addition to on-call ambulance runs and will include a \$40.00 phone stipend. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included the Commissioner Joiner stating Shawn Hage and the entire Colstrip Ambulance staff recommended Kyla for the position. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the new Victim Witness Policy Handbook as presented by Trina Davis. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating the policy was reviewed by the County Attorney. Commissioner Hein explained this is a new requirement to continue receiving grant funds which are used to pay the position's salary. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to adopt the Rosebud County Risk Management Policy for Subrecipient Grant Applications. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating this was necessary to satisfy federal grant requirements when Rosebud County is acting as a pass-through subrecipient for grant funds. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the letter of support for the Rosebud Mine Area F Mining Plan Modification. Commissioner Lee seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating he spoke with Dusty Martens at Westmoreland Mine to discuss all the alternatives presented by the DEQ. The fourth alternative would extend the life of the mine and allow expansion, the others did not. The letter will be sent to the Department of Interior. Rosebud County supports coal and wants to preserve the longevity of the mine. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to approve the State of Montana Standard Lease for Motor Vehicle Office in Colstrip and Forsyth. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Lee stating the lease in Colstrip will be for use of the space in the Human Service Building and in Forsyth for use of office space on the first floor of the Courthouse. Commissioner Joiner noted this is a renewal to the agreement, and there are no fees associated with the agreement, it does provide a good service to the county. Motion carried, 3-0.

Lee, Member, attending via conference call.

Commissioner Hein motioned to approve the consent agenda, to include all claims. Commissioner Lee seconds motion, motion carried, 3-0.

Discussion included Commissioner Hein stating the commitment of the county would need to be specific to county wide projects. Tamara Robertson stated if awarded the grant would be a positive impact to the county, town and surrounding areas with the projects they hope to achieve. The committee will consult with the county prior to making decisions on projects that affect the county. It was also stated that the grant was due by December 31st, 2024 and the award will be announced in the spring. Motion carried, 3-0.

Commissioner Lee motioned to authorize Sam Beyl as the Big Sky Passenger Rail Authority Representation for Rosebud County. Commissioner Hein seconds motion. Discussion included Commissioner Hein stating that the County was not financially supporting the Big Sky Passenger Rail Authority but that additional money has been added to the travel budget for attending meetings if needed. Sam Beyl did state that she will be representing Southeast Montana at a Tourism Conference in April. Motion carried, 3-0.
