**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County, Montana is the governing body of Rosebud County, Montana; and



## RESOLUTION # 1212

### RESOLUTION SETTING PER DIEM POLICY & STANDARD MILEAGE RATES

**WHEREAS** Rosebud County has not changed their per diem policy since October 10, 2023, and;

**WHEREAS** Rosebud County seeks to deviate from the per diem meal rates established by the State of Montana, Section 2-18-501, M.C.A.; and

**WHEREAS** Rosebud County has authority to establish County policy for reimbursement of meal and lodging expenses and per diem rates for County officers, employees, and approved board members who travel for County business. (40 Op. Atty Gen Mont. No. 77);

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2025, THE PER DIEM POLICY FOR ROSEBUD COUNTY IS AS FOLLOWS:**

**The motel room policy** of Rosebud County is to utilize 'State rate' motel rooms whenever possible. Motel reimbursement rates generally will not exceed the state rate of \$110.00 per night plus tax, except as the State of Montana has adjusted the rate for high-cost areas.

Rosebud County recognizes a higher rate of reimbursement may be necessary when traveling to meetings and conferences in and out of state in higher cost areas. A County official, employee or approved board member may request prior approval for actual expenses to attend a meeting in a high-cost city. The request will be reviewed by the Board of County Commissioners, the decision of being approved or denied will be on a case-by-case basis.

Trip reports and motel receipts must be submitted with each reimbursement claim.

**The meal per diem policy** for Rosebud County officials and employees is as follows:

Without a receipt the County will reimburse at the state meal rates, Section 2-18-501, M.C.A., namely Breakfast \$8.25, Lunch \$9.25, and Dinner \$16.00 for a total of \$33.50 per day.

With a receipt the County will pay the face value of the receipt for the meal of the County official or employee up to a maximum of the standard federal rate of Breakfast \$16.00, Lunch \$19.00, and Dinner \$28.00 for a maximum of \$63.00 per day. The County does not reimburse for tips or gratuities, nor does the County reimburse for alcoholic beverages.

The standard federal per diem rate also includes \$5 for daily incidental expenses, however the County does not pay a flat rate for incidental expenses. To be reimbursed, specific incidental expenses (such as parking or taxi) must be supported by a receipt and noted as part of the travel claim. The County may agree to pay over the standard federal rate with prior approval.

**AND WHEREAS** Rosebud County will use the standard mileage rate established as per the Internal Revenue Service for County business travel by a county official, employee or approved board member when utilizing a private vehicle.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the rates set forth above will go into effect on January 1, 2025, and thereafter will follow any adjustments made by the State to the rates set forth in Section 2-18-501, M.C.A.



**Whereas**, House Bill 334 (2013) establishes requirements when public notice is to be provided by posting and is codified as 7-1-2123 MCA.


**7-1-2123. Posting.** (1) *The governing body shall specify by resolution a public location for posting information and shall order erected a suitable posting board.*





Discussion included Commissioner Joiner stating the new director for Colstrip presented an increase pay rate for drivers and EMT's that will be comparable to what Forsyth drivers and EMT's currently make. Sgt Jonas stated that 85% of the county has coverage, based on his experience, and if an officer was out of service area, they would just utilize the radio during the traffic stop and resume reporting once service returned. Commissioner Lee amended the motion to refer the quote to the 911 Board to see if there is funding to help cover the cost of the CAD software purchase. Once a determination is made on funding sources a decision can be made on purchasing the hardware and software. Motion carried, 3-0.
